RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

RULE 15c2-6 ADOPTED

The Commission adopted Rule 15c2-6 (the Penny Stock Fraud Rule), which would impose sales practice requirements on broker-dealers who recommend purchases of certain low-priced, non-NASDAQ over-the-counter securities to persons other than established customers. Rule 15c2-6 is effective as of January 1, 1990. (Rel. 34-27160)

COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

FOIA APPEAL OF REBECCA E. SWENSON

The General Counsel sent a letter to Rebecca E. Swenson in response to her request for documents reflecting submissions by self-regulatory organizations of proposed listing standards and the Commission's responses thereto; and for all documents prepared by the Commission with respect to whether listing standards must be submitted for Commission approval under Section 19 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The General Counsel determined that Ms. Swenson's request for SRO proposals was not reasonably specific, and that, since the Commission's files of these records are not retrievable by topic, it was not possible to identify the particular documents sought. Moreover, such SRO proposals are, to the extent maintained by the Commission, available through the Public Reference Branch. The General Counsel also determined that the FOIA Officer properly withheld the Commission's internal memoranda under Exemption 5 because all responsive documents are pre-decisional and were prepared by the staff for the purpose of advising the Commission during its deliberations prior to its adopting Rule 19c-4. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES ARNOLD S. COHEN, OTHERS

The Atlanta Regional Office filed a Complaint on August 3 in federal court in Chattanooga, Tennessee against Coal Corporation of America, Continental Coal Reserves Ltd., Cumberland Mountain Coal Mine Ltd., Arnold S. Cohen, Joseph A. Banks, William F. McLaughlin, John R. Waterman, William W. Dean, and Daniel R. Jonkers, seeking injunctive relief and an accounting and disgorgement of investor funds involving the registration, antifraud, and broker-dealer registration provisions involving coal mining investment operations in Tennessee. The Complaint alleged that defendants raised approximately \$3.5 million from 550 investors in 35 states. (SEC v. Coal Corporation of America, et al., USDC EDTN, Civil Action No. 1-89-364). CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

KIM G. GIRDNER INDICTED

The Denver Regional Office, the Salt Lake City Branch Office, and the U.S. Attorney for the District of Utah announced that on August 9 the grand jury for the Central Division of the District of Utah returned an indictment against Kim G. Girdner alleging seven counts of perjury. Girdner is charged with having willfully given material false statements to the Commission, which statements were contrary to oath.

Girdner, formerly of Salt Lake City, was employed as a securities trader during the two times that his testimony was taken by the Commission. His alleged false statements concern pre-1933 corporations and his knowledge of any common thread among them, whether Jerry D. Timothy was connected to the companies, whether Girdner was compensated in stock or otherwise to make a market in a company's stock, and whether Girdner knew if anyone had a control block of stock in the companies. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

RYAN MORTGAGE ACCEPTANCE CORPORATION V

A conditional order has been issued granting Ryan Mortgage Acceptance Corporation V an exemption from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with the issuance of collateralized mortgage obligations and the sale of certain residual interests. (Rel. IC-17113 - Aug. 21)

STRONG U.S. GOVERNMENT RESERVES, INC. ; PRUDENTIAL GUARANTEED ADJUSTABLE FUND, L.P.

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until September 14 to request a hearing on an application filed by Strong U.S. Government Reserves, Inc.; and Prudential Guaranteed Adjustable Fund, L.P. for an order declaring that they have ceased to be investment companies. (Rel. IC-17114; IC-17115 - Aug. 21)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NORTHEAST UTILITIES

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Northeast Utilities, a registered holding company, and its subsidiaries, The Connecticut Light & Power Company (CL&P) and Western Massachusetts Electric Company (WMECO), whereby the subsidiaries will amend their existing \$350 million credit facility to permit Northeast to borrow up to \$100 million outstanding at any time and from time-to-time, under the same terms and conditions. DELISTING GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the American Stock Exchange to strike from listing and registration the common stock, \$.01 par value, of ADAMS-RUSSELL INC. (Rel. 34-27145)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change has been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The Pacific Stock Exchange (SR-PSE-89-19) to require equity floor brokers to "give-up" options market maker clearing symbols for equity trades originating on the options floor and sent out over the Intermarket Trading System. (Rel. 34-27146); and The Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-89-39) that would provide procedures governing the commencement of trading on Phlx when it opens an ITS stock before any other market. (Rel. 34-27149)

Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of August 21.

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by The Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-88-32) to clarify its evaluation procedures for equity specialist units. (Rel. 34-27147)
