ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS RE BENCHMARK INTERNATIONAL INVESTMENT CORPORATION AND DAVID PAUL CHIODO AMENDED

The SEC has amended its Order instituting public administrative proceedings under Sections 203(c)(2) and 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940, as amended, against Benchmark International Investment Corporation and David Paul Chiodo issued on August 4, 1989. The Amended Order alleges as an additional charge that since about April 1989 Benchmark and Chiodo have violated the antifraud provisions of the Advisers Act by charging clients fees in excess of those provided for in clients' investment advisory agreements, by failing to disclose the basis of such fees and by failing to account for certain charges imposed on clients' accounts. The original Order was In the Matter of International Investment Corporation, et al. under Release IA-1184 issued August 4, 1989. (Rel. IA-1193)

RULE 2(e) PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST FREDERICK D. WOODSIDE

The Commission instituted proceedings under Rule 2(e) of the Commission's Rules of Practice against Frederick D. Woodside, a certified public accountant and auditor for Dave Mason, R.I.A., Inc. (Mason RIA), a registered investment adviser.

The Order alleges that Woodside (1) wilfully violated Section 207, and wilfully aided and abetted violations of Sections 204 and 206 of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 and Rules 204-2 and 206(4)-2 thereunder; and (2) engaged in improper professional conduct, in that Woodside was not independent at the time that he opined on Mason RIA's financial statements and verified funds and securities in the custody or possession of Mason RIA.

Woodside's independence was compromised by, among other things, Woodside's acceptance of \$15,000 in loans from Mason RIA clients' accounts, the performance of certain bookkeeping functions for, and receipt of referral fees from, Mason RIA.

Woodside, without admitting or denying any of the matters set forth in the Order, consented to the issuance of an Order permanently denying him the privilege of appearing or practicing before the Commission, provided, however, after three years he may apply to the Commission to resume appearing and practicing. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

DAVE MASON, R.I.A., INC. AND DAVE LEE MASON PERMANENTLY ENJOINED

The San Francisco Branch Office filed a complaint on August 21 in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of California seeking to enjoin Dave Mason, R.I.A., Inc. (Mason RIA) and Dave Lee Mason (Mason) from further violations of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

The Complaint alleges that Mason and Mason RIA, among other things, (1) failed to disclose, and misrepresented their receipt of kickbacks totaling \$65,327 in brokerage commissions paid by Mason RIA's clients; (2) misrepresented in filings with the Commission and in advertisements provided to clients Mason's educational background; and (3) failed to disclose loans of client funds to Mason RIA independent public account. (Securities and Exchange Commission v. Dave Mason, R.I.A., Inc., and Dave Lee Mason, U.S.D.C., N.D.CA., Civil Action No. 89-3045 [J.P.V.]) (Rels. IA-1192 and LR-12226)
