

COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

ORDER AFFIRMING/REVERSING FOIA OFFICER'S DETERMINATION

The General Counsel sent a letter to Pamela Ivy Bell, Esq., affirming in part and reversing in part the Freedom of Information Act Officer's determination to deny access to certain information, and granting and denying access to certain other information not considered by the FOIA Officer concerning Pacific Asset Holdings Co. and Cardinal Investment Company. With respect to Pacific, the General Counsel reversed the FOIA Officer's assertion of Exemption 7(A), 5 USC 552(b)(7)(A), and granted access to certain information. With respect to Cardinal, the General Counsel affirmed the FOIA Officer's decision to withhold some of the information he considered, but on the basis of Exemption 8, 5 USC 552(b)(8) instead of Exemption 5, 5 USC 552(b)(5). As to other information not considered by the FOIA Officer, the General Counsel denied access under Exemption 7(D), 5 USC 552(b)(7)(D) and Exemption 8, 5 USC 552(b)(8), and granted access to certain information subject to deletion under Exemption 7(C), 5 USC 552(b)(7)(C). ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST GARY W. CHAMBERS

Public administrative proceedings have been instituted against Gary W. Chambers, former Compliance Director of First Investment Securities, Inc. (FIS). The Order alleges that Chambers failed to reasonably supervise, within the meaning of Section 15(b)(4)(E) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, two brokers with a view to preventing their excessive and unsuitable trading and various misrepresentations of material facts made by them in connection with their trading. The accounts involved were several small California municipalities and local agencies. Among other things, the Order alleges that Chambers did not (1) ensure that the brokers' trading was in conformity with the customers' investment objectives; (2) ensure that the brokers were not churning their accounts; and (3) follow certain of the supervisory and compliance procedures adopted by FIS.

A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether the allegations are true and whether any remedial action is necessary for the protection of investors. (Rel. 34-27298)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PERMANENT INJUNCTION ISSUED AGAINST RICHARD SARMIENTO

On October 3, Chief Judge W. Earl Britt, U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of North Carolina, issued a permanent injunction against Richard Sarmiento for aiding and abetting violations of the antifraud, reporting, and books and records provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The Complaint alleged that Sarmiento, on behalf of an issuer required to file reports under the Exchange Act, supplied a letter of confirmation to that issuer's outside auditors falsely confirming the existence of inventory at Stretchlon Industries, Inc., the company for which Sarmiento was vice president and manager. The issuer's inventory was ultimately overstated by 9% and its net income was overstated by 134%. Sarmiento consented to the injunction, without admitting or denying the Complaint's allegations. The injunction enjoins him from aiding and abetting the aforementioned provisions. (SEC v. Rocky Mount Undergarment Co., Inc., et al., Civil Action No. 89-014, Civ-5, EDNC). (LR-12265)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE HORIZON FUNDS

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 24 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Horizon Funds, Pacific Horizon Funds, Inc., and Pacific Horizon Tax-Exempt Money Market Portfolio, Inc. (collectively, Applicants), seeking an order amending a prior order [Rel. IC-16111, November 4, 1987] to permit the issuance and sale of classes of additional securities representing interests in Applicants' daily dividend investment portfolios under a plan of reorganization. (Rel. IC-17157 - Sept. 29)

STANDARD SECURITY LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY OF NEW YORK

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 24 to request a hearing on an application by Standard Security Life Insurance Company of New York, Standard Security Knox Funds Separate Account B of Standard Security Life Insurance Company of New York, and Directed Services, Inc. for an order granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(C)(2) of the Investment Company Act to permit the deduction of a mortality and expense risk charge from the assets of the Account under a deferred variable annuity contract and an immediate variable annuity certain contract and to permit the deduction of a guaranteed minimum death benefit charge from the accumulation value in the Account under the deferred variable annuity contract. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

SOUTHWESTERN BLECTRIC POWER COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 23 to request a hearing on a proposal by Southwestern Electric Power Company (SWEPCO), subsidiary of Central and South West Corporation, to issue and sell from time to time up to \$75 million aggregate principal amount of its first mortgage bonds (New Bonds) through December 31, 1990. The New Bonds will have maturities of five to thirty years. SWEPCO further proposes that the proceeds from the sale of the New Bonds be used for the acquisition, through December 31, 1990, of all or a portion of SWEPCO's first mortgage bonds, Series S, 11-3/8%, due August 1, 2015. SWEPCO proposes to accomplish such acquisition through a cash tender offer to the holders of the Series S Bonds. (Rel. 35-24961 - Sept. 28)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The New York Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-NYSE-89-24) to require member organizations to file a monthly report indicating all correspondent broker-dealers whose overall ratio of requested extensions of time on payment/ delivery of securities to total transactions for the month exceeds 2%. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of October 2. (Rel. 34-27293)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by: <u>The New York Stock Exchange</u> (SR-NYSE-89-19) to amend its Rules 121 and 123 to ensure that time records are maintained for orders received by a specialist at the post or at a member's booth on the floor from off the floor. (Rel. 34-27294); <u>The Pacific Stock Exchange</u> (SR-PSE-88-1) to eliminate obsolete provisions, update other provisions, and simplify and clarify various membership application and payment procedures set forth in the PSE Constitu-

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Depository Trust Company filed a proposed rule change which has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proposal (SR-DTC-89-16) enables pledge banks in DTC's Collateral Loan Program to demand collateral by means of instructions submitted via DTC's Participant Terminal System. (Rel. 34-27297)
