# **COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS**

FOIA APPEAL OF STEPHEN M. SHAW

The General Counsel sent a letter to Stephen M. Shaw informing him that documents to which the FOIA Officer denied access, under Exemption 8, were not responsive to Mr. Shaw's request for documents providing dollar volume trading data for the top 20 entities for the two week period prior to October 19, 1987, and informing him, that even if the documents were deemed responsive, they could be withheld under Exemption 8. (Rel. FOIA-131)

## **ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS**

MABON NUGENT & CO.

The Commission vacated its Order of January 13, 1983 in which it censured Mabon, Nugent & Co., a broker-dealer registered with the Commission. The Order was based on findings, to which Respondent consented, that it had failed reasonably to supervise an employee subject to its supervision with a view to preventing violations of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

At the conclusion of a subsequent contested proceeding instituted against the employee that Respondent allegedly failed reasonably to supervise, the Commission determined that the allegations against the employee had not been sustained, and dismissed the proceedings against him. The Commission thus eliminated an essential basis for its finding that Respondent had failed to supervise an employee who committed a violation. Under these unusual circumstances, the Commission determined it appropriate to vacate the Order against Respondent.

The Order contained a statement by the Commission alerting broker-dealers to the importance of assuring that supervisory procedures keep pace with expanded activities. In vacating the Order, the Commission reiterated that it adhered to this statement. (Rel. 34-27301)

#### TRADING SUSPENSIONS

TRADING SUSPENDED IN THE SECURITIES OF 16 COMPANIES

The Commission announced the single ten-day suspension of over-the-counter trading in the securities of 16 companies for the period beginning at 9:30 a.m. (EDT) on October 13 and terminating at 11:59 p.m. (EDT) on October 22.

The Commission suspended trading in the securities of the companies in view of questions that have been raised about the adequacy and accuracy of publicly disseminated information concerning, among other things, the corporate histories and financial conditions of the companies, the identities of their shareholders, the length of time those persons have been shareholders, and the claims for exemption from the registration provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 made by these companies and pursuant to which their securities are trading. Specifically, among other things, substantial questions have been raised about the true ownership of the shares in these corporations, the identity of officers and directors, and whether the issuers have distributed and are distributing securities in violation of the registration provisions of the Securities Act. #### **CIVIL PROCEEDINGS**

CIVIL INJUNCTIVE ACTION FILED AGAINST JOSEPH V. OLIVEIRA, JR.

The Boston Regional Office filed a Complaint on September 28 in the U.S. District Court for the District of Massachusetts against Joseph V. Oliveira, Jr. The Complaint alleges that Oliveira violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933, the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 in connection with the operation of investment advisory businesses doing business under the names Oliveira Associates and Universal Services.

The Complaint alleges that Oliveira misappropriated approximately \$240,000 in clients funds and created phony letterhead to make it appear to clients that their funds were invested in legitimate mutual fund shares. It seeks an injunction against defendant from future violations and an accounting of all investor funds received. (SEC v. Joseph V. Oliveira, Jr., USDC MA, 89-2154-Z). (LR-12272)

### **SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS**

PARTIAL ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board filed a proposed rule change and two amendments thereto (SR-MSRB-88-5) to conform provisions of its Arbitration Code, arbitration fees and deposits, and use of predispute arbitration clauses to recent amendments to the Uniform Arbitration Code developed by the Securities Industry Conference on Arbitration. (Rel. 34-27341)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change has been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The American Stock Exchange (SR-Amex-89-22) to permit it to list index warrants based on the Nikkei Stock Average. (Rel. 34-27342); and The Pacific Stock Exchange (SR-PSE-89-25) setting forth additional regulations governing activities of alternate specialists. (Rel. 34-27343)
