CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PERMANENT INJUNCTION ISSUED AGAINST R W TECHNOLOGY, INC. AND JOHN M. MINICUCCI

The Boston Regional Office announced that on October 5 Judge Warren W. Eginton, U.S. District Court of Connecticut, issued Orders of Permanent Injunction against R W Technology, Inc., located in Cheshire, Connecticut, and John M. Minicucci, III, enjoining further violations of the securities laws and compelling RW to make restitution to defrauded investors.

The October 3 Complaint alleged that defendants committed fraud in the unregistered distribution of RW's common stock from January 1, 1989 to the present. Defendants were also charged with including false and misleading statements in RW's periodic reports to the Commission. (SEC v. R W Technology, Inc., et al., No. 89-486-WWE). (LR-12278)
