CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST ROBERT D. MERCER-FALKOFF

The Boston Regional Office filed a Complaint on October 13 against Robert D. Mercer-Falkoff alleging fraud in connection with the offer and sale of the common stock of R W Technology, Inc. Mercer was the president and chief executive officer of RW, a Connecticut company. The Complaint also alleges that Mercer aided and abetted the filing of periodic reports with the Commission that contained misleading statements about RW's operations, capabilities, prospects, and profitability.

Simultaneously, and without admitting or denying its allegations, Mercer consented to an Order of Permanent Injunction enjoining him from further violations of the securities laws. (SEC v. Robert D. Mercer-Falkoff, No. N-89-516-ANH). (LR-12279)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

DEAN WITTER AMERICAN VALUE FUND

An order has been issued allowing Dean Witter Reynolds Inc., et al., to make, until November 6, 1989, exchange offers which are otherwise not in accordance with Rule 11a-3. (Rel. IC-17190 - Oct. 23)

ROYAL BUSINESS FUNDS CORPORATION

An order has been issued declaring that Royal Business Funds Corporation has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-17191 - Oct. 23)

SUN LIFE ASSURANCE COMPANY OF CANADA (U.S.)

An order has been issued exempting Sun Life Assurance Company (U.S.), Sun Life of Canada (U.S.) Variable Account F (the Separate Account), and Clarendon Insurance Agency, Inc. from Sections 26(a)(2) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges from the assets of the Separate Account and from Sections 2(a)(35), 26(a)(2), and 27(c)(2) to permit the deduction of a distribution expense charge from the assets of the Separate Account. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GENERAL PUBLIC UTILITIES CORPORATION

An order has been issued authorizing General Public Utilities Corporation (GPU), a registered holding company, to issue and sell, from time to time through December 3, 1995, up to 2,500,000 shares of its common stock, \$2.50 par value, in connection with a dividend reinvestment and stock purchase plan to be adopted by GPU. GPU requests an exception from the competitive bidding requirements of Rule 50 under Rule 50(a)(5) for its issuance of the common stock. (Rel. 35-24971 - Oct. 23)

SOUTHWESTERN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Southwestern Electric Power Company (SWEPCO), subsidiary of Central and South West to poration, to issue and sell from time to time up to \$75 million aggregate principal account of its first mortgage bonds (New Bonds) through December 31, 1990. The New Bonds will have maturities of five to thirty years. The order further authorizes that the proceeds from the sale of the New Bonds be used for the acquisition, through December 31, 1990, of all or a portion of SWEPCO's first mortgage bonds Series S, 11-3/8% due, August 1, 2015 (Series S Bonds). SWEPCO proposes to accomplish such acquisition through a cash tender offer to the holders of the Series S Bonds. (Rel. 35-24972 - Oct. 24)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE AND APPROVAL OF RELATED TRANSACTION REPORTING EXEMPTIONS

The Commission approved a proposed rule change, granted accelerated approval to amendments to the proposed rule change, and approved related transaction reporting exemptions by the New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-89-5) to trade stock baskets on its equity floor and report basket trades. (Rel. 34-27382)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE AND ORDER GRANTING ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS

The Commission approved a proposed rule change and noticed and granted accelerated approval to amendments to the proposed rule change filed by the Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-88-20) to establish exchange rules to govern the trading of market basket contracts on the floor of the Exchange. (Rel. 35-27383)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE AND RELATED TRANSACTION REPORTING PLAN AND EXEMPTIONS

The Commission approved a proposed rule change, a related transaction reporting plan, and related transaction reporting exemptions by the Midwest Stock Exchange (SR-MSE-89-2) to establish an after-hours trading session for the execution and reporting of transactions in qualified portfolios of eligible securities through its new automated Portfolio Trading System. (Rel. 34-27384)

ORDER APPROVING A PROPOSED TRANSACTION REPORTING PLAN AND GRANTING CERTAIN EXEMPTIONS

The Commission approved a proposed transaction reporting plan by the Midwest Stock Exchange (SR-MSE-89-2) governing the collection, consolidation, and dissemination of information on transactions in reported securities that are executed during the Midwest Secondary Trading Session. The Commission also granted three exemptions from Rule 11Aa3-1 requirements to (1) report transactions in reported securities; (2) specify in the plan the method of consolidation with transaction reports from exchanges and associations reported pursuant to any other effective transaction reporting plan; and (3) provide market identifiers for last sale transaction reports disseminated pursuant to the plan.
