COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

SEC SIGNS MUTUAL ASSISTANCE AGREEMENT WITH THE NETHERLANDS

Chairman Richard C. Breeden and Wim Kok, Minister of Finance for the Kingdom of the Netherlands, today signed an Agreement for Mutual Assistance in the Hague, the Netherlands. The Agreement says that both countries will act to assist the other in a full range of cases which could arise under the securities laws of either nation. It is the most comprehensive formal accord to date on securities enforcement matters between the U.S. and a European country. (Press Release 89-81)

TRADING SUSPENSIONS

TZAAR CORPORATION AND SIMCO DATA GROUP, INC. SECURITIES SUSPENDED

The Commission announced the single ten-day suspension of over-the-counter trading in the securities of Tzaar Corporation and Simco Data Group, Inc., beginning at 9:30 a.m. (EST) on December 11 and terminating at 11:59 p.m. (EST) on December 20. The Commission suspended trading in the securities of the aforementioned companies in view of questions that have been raised about the adequacy and accuracy of publicly disseminated information concerning, among other things, the identities of shareholders, corporate history and the claims for exemption from the registration provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 pursuant to which their securities are trading. Among other things, substantial questions have been raised about the true ownership of shares in these corporations, and whether the issuers have distributed or are distributing securities in violation of the registration provisions of the Securities Act of 1933. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

SEQUENTIAL INFORMATION SYSTEMS CONSENTS TO INJUNCTION

The Commission announced that on December 11, it filed an action in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia seeking a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Sequential Information Systems, Inc., 170 Broadway, New York, New York 10038. Simultaneously with the filing of the Complaint, Sequential consented to entry of the Final Judgment ordering it to file its delinquent Annual Reports within 60 days and enjoining it from further violations of the reporting provisions of the federal securities laws. According to its Annual Report on Form 10-K for fiscal year ended July 31, 1987, Sequential is engaged through subsidiaries in financial consultation, purchase of accounts receivable at a discount, and venture capital financing. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

BANNER LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued exempting Banner Life Insurance Company, Banner Life Variable Annuity Account (Variable Account), and Banner Financial Services Group, Inc., from Sections 26(a)(2) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges from the assets of the Variable Account. MUNICIPAL LEASE SECURITIES FUND, INC. ORDERED TO CONTINUE TO SUSPEND REDEMPTIONS

The Commission entered an order extending the temporary suspension of redemption of shares of Municipal Lease Securities Fund, Inc. (MLS Fund), an open-end investment company registered with the Commission under the Investment Company Act and headquartered in Chicago, Illinois, on the written request of the MLS Fund. The order will remain in effect until 11:59 p.m., E.S.T., on December 15, 1989. The order was entered pursuant to Section 22(e)(3) the Investment Company Act on the grounds that it is not reasonably practicable for the MLS Fund to determine the value of its net assets, and that continuing the suspension of redemptions is necessary for the protection of the MLS Fund's shareholders. NOTICE OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO RESTATED CONSOLIDATED QUOTATION PLAN AND RESTATED CONSOLIDATED TAPE PLANS

The participants in the Consolidated Quotation plan (Rel. 34-27497) and the Consolidated Tape plan (Rel. 34-27498) have filed proposed amendments to the respective plans to introduce a new Consolidated Form to replace the Vendor/Computer Input User Agreements now in use. Publication of the proposed amendments is scheduled to appear in the Federal Register during the week of December 11.

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change has been filed by the American Stock Exchange (SR-Amex-89-29) to amend Section 107 of the Amex Company Guide to provide listing guidelines for new securities not otherwise covered under existing sections of the Company Guide. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of December 11.
