COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

ORDER REVERSING FOIA OFFICER'S DETERMINATION TO DENY ACCESS

The General Counsel sent a letter to Ms. Ellen Walp of Federal Document Retrieval, reversing the FOIA Officer's determination to deny access under FOIA Exemption 7(A), 5 U.S.C. 552(b)(7)(A), to an investigatory file that was responsive to Ms. Walp's request for seven categories of documents concerning the October 19, 1987 market break and the Commission staff's report thereon. The General Counsel determined that disclosure of the investigatory records to which the FOIA Officer denied access could no longer reasonably be expected to interfere with enforcement proceedings. The General Counsel also informed Ms. Walp that his staff had located documents that are responsive to her request, but which were not considered by the FOIA Officer. The General Counsel remanded Ms. Walp's request to the FOIA Officer for further processing in light of these determinations. (Rel. FOIA-137)

ORDER AFFIRMING IN PART, REVERSING IN PART, FOIA OFFICER'S DETERMINATION TO DENY ACCESS

The General Counsel sent a letter to Mark A. Cymrot affirming in part and reversing in part the FOIA Officer's determination that certain documents supporting statements made in the staff's February 1988 report entitled "The October 1987 Market Break" are exempt from disclosure on the basis of FOIA Exemptions 4, 5, and/or 8, 5 U.S.C. 552(b)(4), (5), and (8). In addition, the General Counsel determined that one responsive document, which was not considered by the FOIA Officer, is protected by FOIA Exemption 4 and cannot be released to the requester. The General Counsel released, as an exercise of his discretion, part or all of six documents that are protected by Exemption 8. The General Counsel also granted access to one document that is exempt from disclosure under FOIA Exemption 5. (Rel. FOIA-138)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

MUNICIPAL LEASE SECURITIES FUND ENJOINED, RECEIVER APPOINTED

The Chicago Regional Office announced the filing of a complaint on December 18 in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Illinois seeking temporary, preliminary and permanent injunctions from violations of various antifraud, pricing, books and records, and other provisions of the Investment Company and the Securities Acts, and naming as defendants Municipal Lease Securities Fund, Inc., a registered investment company located in Chicago; Hutchinson Advisers, Inc., the Fund's investment adviser; Hutchinson, Fox, Inc., the Fund's principal underwriter; and Howard H. Hutchinson, the president of each of the other defendants. On the same date, the Court entered a consent order restraining sales and redemptions of Fund shares. The Court further ordered a freeze of the Fund's assets and enjoined the destruction of the Fund's books and records. Also, with the Fund's consent, the Court

appointed a receiver for the Fund who was directed to, among other things, solicit the vote of Fund shareholders concerning alternatives, specified in the Court's order, for the future operation of the Fund. (SEC v. Municipal Lease Securities Fund, Inc., et al., U.S.D.C. N.D. Ill., Civil Action No. 89 C 9212) (LR-12331)

COMPLAINT NAMES ADVANCED VIRAL RESEARCH CORP., OTHERS

The Atlanta Regional Office announced the filing of a complaint in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Florida on December 14 against Advanced Viral Research Corp. (AVR), of Miami, Florida, Bernard Friedland, its president, and William Bregman, its secretary-treasurer, seeking a permanent injunction and other equitable relief. AVR went public in 1986, and raised a total of \$1.9 million through the present.

The complaint alleges that AVR, Friedland, and Bregman from April 1986 through the present violated the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws by, among other things: (1) representing that AVR's drug Reticulose was effective in treating viral infections, while failing to disclose respected medical studies to the contrary; (2) omitting to disclose that a 1967 new drug application pertaining to Reticulose had been rejected by the FDA as "not approvable"; and (3) stating that the University of Miami School of Medicine would conduct clinical testing of Reticulose in the treatment of AIDS, when it had never committed to do so. The Commission also alleges that AVR, aided and abetted by Friedland and Bregman, violated the reporting provisions of the Securities Exchange Act and that AVR violated the registration provisions (Section 5(b)(2)) of the Securities Act. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NATIONAL BOND FUND AND NATIONAL SECURITIES & RESEARCH CORPORATION

A conditional order has been issued exempting National Bond Fund (Fund) and National Securities & Research Corporation (Adviser) from the provisions of Section 17(a) of the Investment Company Act to permit the Adviser of the Fund to purchase certain portfolio securities from the Fund. (Rel. IC-17279 - Dec. 22)

MACKAY-SHIELDS MAINSTAY SERIES FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 22, 1990, to request a hearing on an application filed by MacKay-Shields Mainstay Series Fund for an amendment of a prior order granted under Section 32(a) of the Investment Company Act to bring the prior order into conformity with Rule 32a-3. (Rel. IC - 17280)

LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

UNLISTED TRADING GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the Boston Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in the common stock of eighteen issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchanges and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> (SR-NASD-89-55) filed with the Commission a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 to establish a schedule of charges for its Automated Confirmation Transaction (ACT) system. (Rel. 34-27551)

PARTIAL APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission has partially approved a proposed rule change filed by the <u>New York Stock Exchange</u> (SR-NYSE-89-16) to amend its voting rights listing standards and listing standards for non-U.S. companies. (Rel. 34-27554)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>Philadelphia Stock Exchange</u> (SR-PHLX-89-56) has filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 relating to the execution of three-way orders in foreign currency options.
