# **RULES AND RELATED MATTERS**

RULES GOVERNING DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY AMENDED

The Commission is amending its rules governing delegation of authority. The amendment enables the Director of the Division of Market Regulation to grant broker-dealers exemptions from the requirements of Section 15(b)(8) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, under Section 15(b)(9). ## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

### LARY C. SNODGRASS SANCTIONED

The Commission instituted an administrative proceeding against Lary C. Snodgrass, a certified public accountant residing in Aurora, Nebraska, under Rule 2(e) of the Commission's Rules of Practice. Concurrently with the institution of these proceedings, the Commission accepted Snodgrass' Offer of Settlement in which he consented to the Commission's Opinion and Order without admitting or denying the allegations therein.

In accepting Snodgrass' Offer of Settlement, the Commission found that Snodgrass issued an unqualified audit report on the financial statements of General Electrodynamics Corporation for the fiscal year ended August 31, 1983, which overstated income by \$118,160. The audit report reflected that the \$118,160 represented a debt which had been forgiven when, in fact, it had not been. Accordingly, the Commission found that Snodgrass failed to exercise due professional care in conducting the audit.

The Commission censured Snodgrass and accepted his resignation from appearing or practicing before the Commission provided, however, that after four years, Snodgrass may apply to resume practicing and appearing before the Commission upon meeting certain conditions and qualifications. # **HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

#### CEDAR COAL COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Cedar Coal Company, an indirect subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, Inc., to lease additional equipment with an aggregate acquisition cost estimated at \$95,000 from a nonassociate company. (Rel. 35-23975 - Dec. 31, 1985)

#### ALABAMA POWER COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Alabama Power Company, subsidiary of The Southern Company, to enter into the financing of pollution control facilities in an amount not to exceed \$21 million. Jurisdiction has been reserved over additional financing of up to \$22.5 million. (Rel. 35-23976 - Dec. 31, 1985)

#### SENECA RESOURCES CORPORATION

An order has been issued authorizing Seneca Resources Corporation, subsidiary of National Fuel Gas Company, to issue secured short-term notes to banks, and to extend their maturity. (Rel. 35-23977 - Dec. 31, 1985)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed by: The National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. (SR-NASD-85-36) to provide for automated executions up to 1,000 shares in its Computer Assisted Execution Service. (Rel. 34-22750); (SR-NASD-85-37) to require NASD members to maintain a record of aggregate "short" positions in NASDAQ securities in all customer and proprietary firm accounts and to report such information to the NASD on a monthly basis. Members reports will be non-public and will be used by the NASD solely for an internal short sale study. (Rel. 34-22761); and The Boston Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-BSE-85-10) to establish guidelines for members that intend to function solely as independent floor brokers. (Rel. 34-22759)

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a pubic company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
