ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST COSENTINO & DEFELICE, INC. ET AL

The New York Regional Office announced that the Commission has ordered administrative proceedings pursuant to the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Cosentino & DeFelice, Inc. (Registrant), a registered broker-dealer located in New York City; Edward DeFelice (E. DeFelice), the president, a director, and 25-50% shareholder of Registrant; Joseph Cosentino, the vice-president, treasurer and secretary of Regis trant; Richard DeFelice (R. DeFelice), the comptroller and a registered representa tive of Registrant; and Elizabeth Bamberg, a registered representative of Registrant.

The Order for Public Proceedings alleges that Registrant, E. DeFelice, Cosentino, R. DeFelice and Bamberg violated and/or aided and abetted violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. It also alleges that Registrant, aided and abetted by E. DeFelice, Cosentino and R. DeFelice, violated the escrow, customer protection, bookkeeping, record preservation, financial reporting and supplemental reporting provisions of the Exchange Act and the rules promulgated thereunder.

A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether the allegations against Registrant, E. DeFelice, Cosentino, R. DeFelice and Bamberg are true and, if so, to decide what, if any, remedial action will be appropriate. (Rel. 34-22749)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

PRUCO LIFE SERIES FUND, INC.

An order has been issued exempting Pruco Life Series Fund, Inc. from the provisions of Section 2(a)(41) of the Investment Company Act and Rules 2a-4 and 22c-1 to the extent requested. This order permits Applicant, which serves as the underlying investment medium for certain variable life insurance contracts, to use the amortized cost valuation method for the purpose of valuing the short-term debt obligations held in certain of its portfolios. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

EASTERN UTILITIES ASSOCIATES

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 31, 1986, to request a hearing on a request by Eastern Utilities Associates, a registered holding company, for exception from Rule 50 in order to issue and sell common stock pursuant to the company's Dividend Reinvestment and Common Share Purchase Plan. TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

THE UNITED STATES TRUST COMPANY OF NEW YORK

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 31, 1986, to request a hearing on an application by Citicorp, under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939. The application declares that the trusteeship of the United States Trust Company of New York (Trust Company), under four existing indentures as well as two pooling and servicing agreements dated October 1, 1985, under which certificates evidencing interests in a pool of mortgage loans have been issued, is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disgualify Trust Company from acting as trustee. Trust Company is acting as trustee under the following four indentures dated: 1) February 15, 1972, involving the issuance of floating rate notes due 1989; 2) March 15, 1977, involving the issuance of various series of unsecured and unsubordinated notes; 3) August 25, 1977, involving the issuance of rising rate notes, Series A; and 4) April 21, 1980, involving the issuance of various series of unsecured and unsubordinated notes. ACQUISITIONS OF SECURITIES.

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a pubic company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
