RULE 202(a)(1)-1 PROPOSED FOR COMMENT

The Commission is proposing for public comment Rule 202(a)(1)-1 under the Investment Advisers Act of 1940. The proposed rule would deem a transaction not resulting in a change of actual control or management of an investment adviser not be an an assignment requiring approval of the adviser's clients.

Comments should be submitted in triplicate to John Wheeler, Secretary, Securities and Exchange Commission, 450 Fifth Street, NW, Washington, DC 20549. Comments must be received by March 21 and should refer to File No. S7-7-86. All submissions will be available for injection in the Public Reference Room. (Rel. IA-1013)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved proposed rule change filed by: The New York Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-NYSE-85-46) to modify rates of reimbursement specified in supplementary material to Rules 451 and 465 for the forwarding of proxy and annual report mailing to beneficial shareholders. (Rel. 34-22908); and The Chicago Board Options Exchange, Incorporated (SR-CBOE-85-48) to amend its Rule 19.2 to extend the time limit for filling an application for review of an action of the Exchange before the Exchange's Appeals Committee. (Rel. 34-22910)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved, on an accelerated basis, a proposed rule change filed by the Pacific Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-PSE-86-1) to establish, for the purpose of member reporting duties, account origin codes which disclose the principal account for which an order is executed, and to require such codes to appear on all cards or tickets for agency orders. (Rel. 34-22911)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The New York Stock Exchange, Inc. filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-NYSE-86-7) to modify its rules governing joint accounts as applied to the options floor. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of February 17. (Rel. 34-22912)

The Commission approved, on an accelerated basis, a proposed rule change filed by the New York Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-NYSE-86-5). The proposal consists of several new interpretations to NYSE Rule 412 and refines several existing interpretations. The Commission is granting the NYSE's request for accelerated effectiveness because the improved interpretations should be in effect before Rule 412's requirements regarding customer account transfers become fully effective on February 24. The proposal also states that the NYSE will phase-in member use of National Securities Clearing Corporation's Automated Customer Account Transfer Service over the next 120 days. The Order also requests public comment on the proposal. The Commission, however, does not believe that it is in the public interest to delay the effectiveness of the proposal in view of NYSE's active effort to solicit member comments and recommendations.
