EXCEPTION CONTRACTOR

COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

HOTELERA PLAYA FLAMINGO, S.A.

The Commission announced that it previously placed the securities of Hotelera Playa Flamingo, S.A., doing business as Flamingo Beach Hotel Company and Flamingo Beach Resort of Costa Rica, on the Foreign Restricted List. The Commission had received information that Flamingo was offering and had possibly sold securities without the required registration under the Securities Act of 1933. (Rel. 33-6626)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

EDWARD ALLAN HARSH BARRED

Public administrative proceedings previously instituted have been settled against Edward Allan Harsh. The Order for Proceedings alleged that between December 1979 and December 1982, Harsh was involved in the offer and sale of two forms of securities: (1) interests in research and development partnerships; and (2) investment contracts consisting of fractional undivided interests in cargo containers coupled with collateral management, maintenance and insurance arrangements. The investments were sold through FoodSource, Inc., a company based in the San Francisco area. Harsh submitted an offer of settlement in which, without admitting or denying the allegations in the Order for Proceedings, he consented to an Order finding that he violated the registration and fraud provisions in connection with the two investment programs. The Commission barred Harsh from association in any capacity with any broker-dealer, investment company, investment adviser or municipal securities dealer, provided that after two and one-half years, he may reapply for association in a non-proprietary, non-supervisory capacity upon a showing that he will be adequately supervised. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CENTURY LIFE OF AMERICA

An order has been issued granting Century Life of America (CLA), Century Variable Account and Century Investors of America, Inc. exemptions from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 22(c), 27(c)(1) and 27(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rules 6e-3(T)(b)(12)(ii), 6e-3(T)(b)(13)(iv) and 22c-1. The exemptions permit the deduction of a contingent deferred administrative charge in connection with the issuance of flexible premium variable life insurance contracts. Under this expense structure, the deferred charges will be set aside in the general account CLA. (Rel. IC-14950 - Feb. 20)

LEHMAN INTERNATIONAL DOLLAR FUNDS, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 10 to request a hearing on an application by Lehman International Dollar Funds, Inc. for an order declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-14951 - Feb. 20)

METROPOLITAN SERIES FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 18 to request a hearing on an application filed by Metropolitan Series Fund, Inc. for an order exempting it from Section 2(a)(41) of the Investment Company Act and Rules 2a-4 and 22c-1 so that Metropolitan may use the amortized cost valuation method for the short-term debt obligations held in certain of its portfolios. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ALLEGHENY POWER SYSTEM, INC.

An order has been issued authorizing Allegheny Power System, Inc., a registered holding company, to issue and sell short-term notes to banks and commercial paper dealers through September 30, 1987 in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$110 million. This amount includes any short-term debt still outstanding under the Commission's prior authorization in Rel. 35-23395, August 14, 1984. (Rel. 35-24024 - Feb. 21)

VERMONT YANKEE NUCLEAR POWER CORPORATION

An order has been issued authorizing Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Corporation, subsidiary of New England Electric System and Northeast Utilities, to issue and sell short-term notes to banks to evidence its borrowings under lines of credit with those banks up to a maximum amount of \$16 million through August 31, 1987. (Rel. 35-24025 - Feb. 21)

JERSEY CENTRAL POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Jersey Central Power & Light Company, Metropolitan Edison Company, Pennsylvania Electric Company, Cherry Hills Fuels Corporation and their parent, General Public Utilities Corporation (GPU), whereby Cherry Hills will reacquire all of its capital stock from GPU and discontinue its operations. NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 17 to request a hearing on a proposal by National Fuel Gas Company, a registered holding company, to loan \$200,000 to a nonaffiliated company in return for a note and a preferred stock option. (Rel. 35-24027 - Feb. 21)
