AMENDMENTS TO TEMPORARY FORM SE FOR EDGAR, THE PILOT ELECTRONIC DISCLOSURE SYSTEM

The Commission amended its regulations governing the format and use of Form SE to facilitate the making of Williams Act filings in the Commission's Pilot electronic disclosure system, Edgar, and to relate the Form SE to a specific electronic filing. (Rel. 33-6634)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST BARRY L. ASMAN, OTHERS

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings against Barry L. Asman of North Bellmore, New York, Kenneth Schlossberg of E. Brunswick, New Jersey, and John Hartung of Manalapan, New Jersey, all of whom were registered representatives employed by the same broker-dealer registered with the Commission.

The Order for Proceedings alleges that Asman, from June 1981 to October 1983, Hartung, from June 1981 to January 1983, and Schlossberg, from January 1983 to October 1983, wilfully violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 in that they misappropriated approximately \$1.5 million from a broker-dealer in connection with stock borrow and stock loan transactions; falsified a broker-dealer's books and records; and accepted monies in exchange for negotiating, on behalf of a broker-dealer, stock loan transactions at interest rates unfavorable to it.

A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether the allegations against Asman, Schlossberg and Hartung are true and, if so, to determine what, if any, remedial action would be appropriate. (Rel. 34-23089)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

WESTERN RESERVE LIFE ASSURANCE CO. OF OHIO

An order has been issued granting Western Reserve Life Assurance Co. of Ohio, WRL Series Life Account, and Pioneer Western Distributors, Inc. an exemption from the provisions of paragraph (c)(2) of Rule 6e-3(T), to treat the disability waiver rider for certain flexible premium variable life insurance contracts as incidental insurance benefits within the meaning of the rule. APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the New York Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-NYSE-86-1) that permits it to list and trade options on the broad-based NYSE Beta Index. (Rel. 34-23102)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities, Inc. filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-86-7) which became effective upon filing under Section 19(b)(3)(A). The proposal amends the NASD By-Laws to clarify that a refusal to remove restrictions imposed on an NASD member firm at a pre-membership interview is subject to review by the NASD's Board of Governors. The Board of Governors' decision would then be reviewable by the Commission. (Rel. 34-23105)
