ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

MARK PARNASS SANCTIONED

The Commission today ordered public administrative proceedings under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Mark Parnass. Parnass submitted an Offer of Settlement which the Commission accepted. Without admitting or denying the allegations in the Order, Parnass consented to the Order making findings that he violated the registration provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and ordering his suspension for 60 days from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company, municipal securities broker or municipal securities dealer.

The Order for Proceedings alleges that Parnass sold unregistered Crab House common stock in 1983 in violation of the registration provisions when he was employed as a registered representative at M.H. Meyerson & Co. in its Ft. Lauderdale office. (Rel. 34-23250)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

THOMAS T. CHERRY, OTHERS NAMED IN CIVIL ACTION

The Fort Worth Regional Office announced that on May 8 a civil action was filed in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Texas, Fort Worth Division, seeking to enjoin Thomas T. Cherry, Michael L. Rasberry and Thomas A. Draschil of Fort Worth, Grand Prairie and San Antonio, Texas, respectively, from further violations of the registration, antifraud and broker-dealer registration provisions of the securities laws. The complaint alleged that the defendants sold the securities of Cherry Ventures, Inc. which, from September 1984 through December 1985, raised \$2.7 million from approximately 220 investors through the sale of fractional undivided interests in seven oil and gas programs. It is further alleged that in connection with the offer and sale of these securities, the defendants misrepresented, among other things, the use of the offering proceeds, the financial condition of the issuer, past production and the risks and merits of investing. (SEC v. Thomas T. Cherry, et al., CA 4-86-384-K, USDC NDTX, Fort Worth Division). (LR-11102)

SIPC AFFORDS PROTECTION TO CUSTOMERS OF BEACON SECURITIES, INC.

The Atlanta Regional Office announced that on May 2 Judge Sol Blatt, Jr., U.S. District Court for the District of South Carolina, entered an Order approving the application of the Securities Investor Protection Corporation providing the customers of Beacon Securities, Inc. of Hilton Head, South Carolina, with the protection afforded by the Securities Investor Protection Act. William Hays, of Atlanta, was appointed trustee for the liquidation of the Beacon's business. The liquidation proceeding has been removed to the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of South Carolina. (SEC v. Beacon Financial Group, Inc., et al., USDC DSC, Civil Action No. 2-85-2960-8). (LR-11103)
