### "JUNK BONDS" ROLE IN TENDER OFFER FINANCING

Noninvestment grade debt is used to finance takeovers more than in the past, constituting about 14% of all tender offer financing in the first six months of 1985, compared to less than 1% of all tender offer financing between 1981 and 1984, according to a study by the Securities and Exchange Commission's Office of the Chief Economist that was released yesterday. Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
