### **ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS**

#### DAVID JAMES RAPAPORT DEFAULTS

The New York Regional Office announced that in administrative proceedings ordered under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, the Commission issued Findings and Order Imposing Remedial Sanctions by Default against David James Rapaport. Rapaport, formerly a general partner of a registered broker-dealer, failed to answer the Order Instituting Proceedings and, therefore, was in default.

On the basis of the Order Instituting Proceedings, the Commission found that on June 19, 1985, Rapaport was convicted in U.S. District Court, upon a plea of guilty, of filing a false tax return. The Commission ordered that Rapaport be barred from associating with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser, or municipal securities dealer. (Rel. 34-23310)

### PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST FRANK MANDERS

The Commission instituted public proceedings against Frank Manders under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The Order for Proceedings alleges that Manders wilfully violated and aided and abetted violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the antifraud provisions of the Exchange Act. The Order alleges that from at least January 1983 to about October 5, 1984, Manders engaged in the offer and sale of unregistered securities in the form of secured and unsecured promissory notes of Newman Companies, Inc. Approximately \$11.4 million was raised from about 800 investors through these offerings. The Order also alleges that Manders made and caused to be made to investors material misrepresentations and omissions regarding: the use of investor proceeds; the financial condition of Newman Co.; and the first mortgages on land collateralizing the secured promissory notes. ## **HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

#### NATIONAL FUEL GAS

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 21 to request a hearing on a proposal by National Fuel Gas Company (National), a registered holding company, to extend financing up to an aggregate principal amount of \$250 million to its subsidiaries, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation, Penn-York Energy Corporation and National Fuel Gas Supply Corporation, through the issuance and sale by National of one or more series of its debentures and through long-term loans by National to the subsidiaries. National also seeks authority to purchase its 12-7/8% debentures, due December 1, 1998, and its 11-3/4% debentures, due December 1, 1998, through tender offers for cash. (Rel. 35-24135 - June 26)

#### THE COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC.

An order has been issued authorizing the issuance and sale of common stock and promissory notes to the Columbia Gas System, Inc., a registered holding company, by Columbia Natural Resources, Inc. (CNR), its subsidiary, and authorizing short-term borrowings by CNR from Columbia and/or through the Intrasystem Money Pool. The order also releases jurisdiction over the issuance and sale of installment promissory notes by Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc. to Columbia during 1986. Jurisdiction continues to be reserved over the transactions by those applicants-declarants who are subject to state jurisdiction pending completion of the record. (Rel. 35-24137 - June 27)
