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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### JAMES MITCHELL NEWMAN BARRED

The New York Regional Office announced that in administrative proceedings ordered under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, the Commission barred James Mitchell Newman, of Demerest, New Jersey, from association with a broker-dealer. The Findings and Order Imposing Sanctions were based upon Newman's default in the proceedings.

The Order found that Newman, acting with others, engaged in an insider trading scheme from 1973 to 1975 in which information about proposed corporate acquisitions was stolen from Morgan Stanley & Co. and used to trade in thousands of shares of target companies' securities. Among the securities purchased were Certaineed Products Corp., Funk Seeds International, Inc., Magnavox Co. and Occidental Petroleum Corp.

The Commission found not only that Newman's participation in these transactions violated the antifraud provisions but also that he had been convicted in May 1982 of conspiracy to commit mail and securities fraud, seven counts of securities fraud and six counts of mail fraud. The convictions related to later aspects of the scheme.

Finding Newman's past violations to have been calculated, repetitive, contrary to the basis ethical principles of the securities industry and motivated solely by the desire for personal enrichment, the Commission barred him from association with any broker-dealer. (Rel. 34-23372)

### LANDIS SECURITIES CORP. REVOKED; PHILIP S. LANDIS BARRED

In administrative proceedings ordered under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, Landis Securities Corporation (LSC), a registered broker-dealer located in Reston, Virginia, and Philip S. Landis (Landis), its president and sole stockholder, have, without admitting or denying the finding of violations, consented to an order instituting public proceedings, making findings and imposing remedial sanctions.

The Order finds that: LSC and Landis violated registration and antifraud provisions in the offer and sale of five oil and gas limited partnerships; LSC and Landis made false and misleading statements and omitted to state material facts in the offer and sale of these securities; and Landis misappropriated \$650,000 of investors monies and failed to return to investors another \$350,000 of excess proceeds.

The Order revokes LSC's broker-dealer registration and bars Landis from association with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser, municipal securities dealer, or municipal securities broker. (Rel. 34-23373)

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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### MEADOW FRESH FARMS INTERNATIONAL CORP., OTHERS ENJOINED

The Atlanta Regional Office announced that on June 11 Meadow Fresh Foods International Corporation (MF Foods), Meridian Management, Inc. and Mickale T. Hood consented, without admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's March 26, 1986 complaint, to Permanent Injunctions entered by the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Georgia. Hood further agreed to return over \$24,000 to investors.

The complaint alleges violations of the registration and broker-dealer registration provisions in addition to the antifraud provision of the Securities and Exchange Acts. The complaint further alleges that from approximately February 1984 through August 1984, the defendants sold approximately 5.5 million shares of Meadow Fresh Farms, Inc. (MF Farms) and MF Foods common stock to over 480 investors nationwide, raising

over \$1.5 million. In effecting these sales, the complaint alleges that the defendants made numerous misrepresentations of material facts and omitted to state material facts concerning, among other things, the use of proceeds received from investors; that a public offering of MF Farms and/or MF Foods common stock would be made for at least \$1.00 per share; the financial condition of MF Farms and MF Foods; the commissions and/or other remuneration being paid to the individual defendants; and the price of the stock. (SEC v. Meadow Fresh Farms, Inc., et al., USDC NDGA, Atlanta Division, Civil Action No. C86-697A). (LR-11141)

#### **PMI HOLDINGS CORPORATION NAMED IN COMPLAINT**

The Commission filed a civil injunctive action on July 2 in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia against PMI Holdings Corporation of New York, New York. The complaint alleges violations of the reporting provisions of the securities laws and seeks a judgment of permanent injunction and other equitable relief.

The Commission alleges that PMI, as part of a continuing course of violative conduct extending over several years, failed to file its Annual Report on Form 10-K for its fiscal year ended December 31, 1985, and its Quarterly Report on Form 10-Q for its fiscal quarters ended March 31, 1986 and September 30, 1985, filed late Annual and Quarterly Reports and failed to file Notifications of Late Filing. The Commission requests that the Court order PMI to file its delinquent Annual and Quarterly Reports and enjoin it from further violations of the reporting provisions of the securities laws. (SEC v. PMI Holdings Corporation, USDC DC, Civil Action No. 86-1872). (LR-11152)

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## **INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

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### **THOMSON MCKINNON GLOBAL TRUST**

An order has been issued on an application filed by Thomson McKinnon Global Trust, and Thomson McKinnon Investment Trust, both open-end, diversified management investment companies, together with Thomson McKinnon Securities, Inc., their distributor and underwriter (collectively, Applicants), amending a previous order and exempting Applicants from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c) and 22(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rules 22c-1 and 22d-1 to permit them to assess and, in certain cases, waive a contingent deferred sales charge on redemptions of their shares. (Rel. IC-15187 - June 30)

### **BERLINER HANDELS- UND FRANKFURTER BANK**

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 25 to request a hearing on an application filed by Berliner Handels- und Frankfurter Bank, a German commercial bank, and its subsidiary, BHF Finance (Delaware) Inc., for an order exempting them from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. (Rel. IC-15188 - July 2)

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## **HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

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### **NEW ORLEANS PUBLIC SERVICE INC.**

An order has been issued authorizing New Orleans Public Service Inc. (NOPSIS), subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc., to issue, under a negotiated private placement with one or more institutional investors, not to exceed \$25 million of secured notes and to issue and deliver first mortgage bonds as security for said notes. (Rel. 35-24140 June 30)

A supplemental order has been issued regarding a proposal by NOPSIS to issue and sell secured notes. The supplemental order corrects the maturity date of secured notes authorized to issue and sell from July 1, 1986 to July 1, 1996. (Rel. 35-24140A - July 1)

### **CENTERIOR ENERGY CORPORATION**

An order has been issued on an application by Centerior Energy Corporation approving the fees payable to investment bankers retained in connection with its acquisition of all of the outstanding common stock of the Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company and the Toledo Edison Company. (Rel. 35-24141 - June 30)

## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Municipal Securities Rule-making Board (SR-MSRB-86-9) requiring inter-dealer and customer confirmations to require a specific designation if the securities identified by the issuer or sold by the underwriter are subject to federal taxation. (Rel. 34-23402)

### REQUEST FOR ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Securities Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-NSCC-86-7) modifying the ACAT rules to provide that NSCC's standard guarantee, which arises from the CNS system on T+4, will apply to ACAT-CNS items on T+5 only if the member with the deliver obligation has paid to NSCC any settlement obligation due on the day the delivery obligation arose. NSCC has requested accelerated approval of the proposed rule change. (Rel. 34-23401)
