## **CORPORATE REORGANIZATION RELEASES**

AMAREX, INC.

The Commission filed a brief on August 6 in the appeal by the Amarex, Inc. to the District Court in a Chapter 11 reorganization case urging that subordination of claims by security owners against a debtor is not warranted under the Bankruptcy Code merely because the claim would not have existed "but for" the claimant's purchase of the debtor's securities. The Commission argued that investor claims are not subject to subordination unless the illegality on which they are based occurs in a securities transaction. (In re Amarex, Inc., Civ. No. 86-1250, WDOK). (CR-359)

### CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST DOVER DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION, OTHERS

The Los Angeles Regional Office filed a complaint on July 29 in the U.S. District Court for the Central Distrtict of California to permanently enjoin Dover Development Corporation, Professional Resources, Inc. (PRI), David Leroy Bustrum, Robert Gray Gibson and Telvin Arnold Hagen from violations of the antifraud, registration and broker-dealer registration provisions of the securities laws.

The complaint alleges that from 1981 through the present, the defendants raised approximately \$4.5 million from at least 200 investors located in several states through the offer and sale of unregistered securities in the form of interests in real estate limited partnerships. The defendants effectuated sales through the dissemination of written offering materials containing numerous misrepresentations concerning, among other things, the use of partnerships funds and the defendants' business activities. The complaint also alleges that Dover and PRI, aided and abetted by Bustrum, Gibson and Hagen, failed to register as a broker-dealer.

The defendants consented to the permanent injunction, without admitting or denying the allegations in the complaint. The order also requires the defendants to account for funds raised. (SEC v. Dover Development Corporation, et al., USDC CDCA, Civil Action No. 86-4934). (LR-11190)

# **INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

CENTENNIAL GOVERNMENT TRUST; CENTENNIAL TAX EXEMPT TRUST

#### ALLEGHENY POWER SYSTEM

A supplemental order has been issued releasing jurisdiction previously reserved with regard to The Potomac Edison Company in a prior Commission order [Rel. 35-23894, November 6, 1985] which authorized the issuance of guarantees concerning workers' compensation liabilities by Allegheny Power System, Inc. (APS), a registered holding company, on behalf of Potomac, West Penn Power Company and other APS subsidiaries. The order reserves jurisdiction pending completion of the record regarding state authorization of the issuance of a guarantee by Allegheny Power Service Corporation on behalf of West Penn. The proposed rule change would also exempt from the suitability requirement primary offerings of direct participation programs for which an application for inclusion on the NASDAQ System or listing on a registered national securities exchange has been approved. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of August 11. (Rel. 34-23515)

### IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE
