U.S. SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CIVIL ACTION FILED AGAINST ANTHONY M. FRANCO

The Commission today filed a civil action for permanent injunctive relief against Anthony M. Franco, alleging that he violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Without admitting or denying the allegations in the complaint, Franco consented to a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction.

The complaint alleges that on or about June 12, 1985, Franco, chairman and chief executive officer of Anthony M. Franco, Inc., a Detroit, Michigan public relations counselling firm, purchased the common stock of Crowley, Milner and Company while in possession of material, nonpublic information relating to negotiations concerning a proposed acquisition of Crowley by the Oakland Holding Company, which information Franco acquired by virtue of his position as Crowley's public relations consultant. Franco allegedly rescinded the trade after Crowley and the American Stock Exchange learned of his purchase. (SEC v. Anthony M. Franco, USDC DC, Civil Action No. 86-2382). (LR-11206)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ZERO COUPON BOND FUND

KENTUCKY POWER COMPANY; COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC.

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until September 15 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following under the same release: Kentucky Power Company - subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, to enter into a further amendment of its revolving credit agreement evidencing borrowings in the aggregate principal amount of up to \$75 million, under which the banks involved in the transaction would extend their commitments from December 31, 1987 to December 31, 1990. All other terms and conditions of borrowing under the Revolving Credit Agreement shall remain unchanged; and Columbia Gas System, Inc. - a registered holding company, to further amend a \$300 million Credit Agreement, previously authorized by the Commission, as amended, to provide for a three-eighths of one percent increase to the existing borrowing margins for certificate of deposit and LIBOR options and for certain additional protective covenants. Proposed rule changes have been filed by: The Midwest Securities Trust Company (SR-MSTC-86-5) that would amend Articles III and IV of its by-laws governing the structure of its Board of Directors. The proposal would (1) entitle the MSTC's President ex-officio status on the Board; (2) divide the other 17 Board members into three classes for election purposes; and (3) provide that both MSTC's Chairman and Vice-Chairman (but not the President) are chosen from and by Board members. (Rel. 34-23546); and The Options Clearing Corporation (SR-OCC-86-17) that would permit the cross-margining of securities options cleared by OCC with futures and commodity options cleared by the Intermarket Clearing Corporation.
