ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS ORDERED AGAINST DAVID L. WILLIAMS

The Commission ordered public administrative proceedings under Sections 15(b)(6) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 against David L. Williams, president of Blondheim Investors, Inc., a registered investment adviser in New Hampshire that has filed for reorganization under Chapter 11 of the U.S. Bankruptcy Code.

The Commission's order alleges that an injunction was entered in the U.S. District Court, District of New Hampshire, against Williams enjoining him from further violating the registration and antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933, the antifraud provisions of the Exchange Act, and from further aiding and abetting violations of Sections 204, 206(1), 206(2) and 206(4) of the Advisers Act. That injunction provides a basis for the Commission to institute an administrative proceeding to determine whether sanctions against Williams are in the public interest. (Rel. 34-23551)
