SAB NO. 63

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

FINAL JUDGMENT ENTERED AGAINST L. GLENN NAFF

The Commission announced that on September 10 the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against L. Glenn Naff, enjoining him from violations of the reporting provisions concerning ownership of stock of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Naff consented to the Final Judgment without admitting or denying any of the allegations in the Commission's complaint.

The complaint, filed simultaneously with Naff's Consent, alleged that Naff accumulated more than five percent of the outstanding common stock of Martin Processing, Inc. (MPI), by at least July 1981, but failed to file timely with the Commission a statement on Schedule 13D, and prompt amendments thereto, with respect to his purchases and other material events. Subsequent to that time, Naff continued to buy and sell MPI common stock and obtained trading authority over several accounts that also bought and sold MPI stock. Naff did not properly file a Schedule 13D until August 1985, which disclosed that he had personal ownership of approximately 9.5% of the outstanding stock of MPI, and trading authority over accounts in the names of individuals that held an additional 8%. COLUMBUS AND SOUTHERN OHIO ELECTRIC COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued amending the authorization granted to Columbus & Southern Ohio Electric Company (C&SOE), subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, and Conesville Coal Preparation Company (CCPC), subsidiary of C&SOE. The interest rate per annum on the Promissory Note issued by CCPC to C&SOE in connection with the transfer of the Conesville Coal Preparation Plant assets from C&SOE to CCPC will be equal to 10.19 percent rather than the previously authorized 11.15 percent per annum.
