RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

INTERPRETIVE RELEASE CONCERNING RULE 10b-6

The Commission published an interpretive release concerning the application of Rule 10b-6 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 to secondary shelf-registered distributions. The interpretation provides that the extent to which a shelf shareholder is subject to the restrictions of Rule 10b-6 will depend upon whether the shelf shareholder is an affiliated purchaser of the issuer or of any other shelf sharheolder, and whether the shelf shareholder has distributed his participation in the shelf distribution. The release also clarifies the circumstances under which broker-dealers will be subject to Rule 10b-6 when they sell shelf-registered securities on behalf of shelf shareholders. (Rel. 34-23611)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

C. E. CARLSON, INC. AND CHARLES E. CARLSON SANCTIONED

The Commission imposed sanctions on C. E. Carlson, Inc., a Golden, Colorado brokerage firm, and Charles E. Carlson, the firm's president. The firm's broker-dealer registration was suspended for two months, and Carlson was suspended from association with any broker or dealer for eight months. In addition, both the firm and Carlson were prohibited from participating in any securities offering for one year. The sanctions are effective October 6.

In December 1981, the firm was underwriter on a best efforts basis of an offering of 30,000,000 shares of the common stock of Saratoga Mines, Inc. The prospectus provided that, unless 20,000,000 shares were sold to the public within a specified period of time, investors' money would be refunded. The Commission found that, in May 1982, respondents fraudulently closed the offering by arranging for insider purchases of the remaining unsold portion of the 20,000,000-share minimum, using borrowed funds that were subsequently repaid from the proceeds of the offering.

In imposing sanctions, the Commission stated that "[i]n derogation of their responsibility to ... investors, [respondents] created the facade of a successful offering, vitiating the condition upon which investors had relied." (Rel. 34-23610)
