BRANDON BECKER APPOINTED NEW ASSOCIATE DIRECTOR-FOR THE OFFICE OF SELF-REGULATORY OVERSIGHT

COMPLAINT NAMES INTERNATIONAL TELDATA CORPORATION, OTHERS

The San Francisco Branch Office filed a complaint on September 16 in the federal district court in Las Vegas, Nevada seeking permanent injunctions against Charles W. Anshen, Richard J. Candelaria, Estelle Eizenberg Anshen, International Teldata Corporation, Louis Miranti, and Edward R. Talbot. The complaint charges the Anshens, Candelaria, Teldata and Talbot with violations of the registration provisions of the securities laws relating to the unregistered issuance and distribution of Teldata stock. Candelaria, the Anshens, Miranti and Talbot are also charged with violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws in connection with several schemes to misappropriate Teldata stock worth in excess of \$5 million. In addition, Teldata, Candelaria and Miranti are charged with violations of the issuer reporting provisions; Charles Anshen and Candelaria are charged with making misrepresentations to Teldata's auditors; and Candelaria and Miranti are charged with stock ownership reporting violations.
