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## RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

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### NEW RULE 14b-2 AND OTHER RULE AMENDMENTS ADOPTED

The Commission adopted: (1) new Rule 14b-2, relating to banks' obligations in connection with forwarding communications to beneficial owners and supplying beneficial owners' names, addresses, and securities positions to registrants; (2) corresponding and clarifying amendments to Rules 14a-1, 14a-13, 14b-1, 14c-1 and 14c-7; and (3) amendments to Rule 14a-3 regarding when and under what conditions registrants are no longer obligated to deliver annual reports or proxy statements to security holders. 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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### OWEN V. KANE SUSPENDED

The Commission suspended Owen V. Kane, a former vice president in the Minneapolis office of A. G. Becker, Incorporated, from association with any broker or dealer for six months effective December 15.

The Commission found that, in December 1981 and January 1982, Kane was responsible for Becker's unlawful resale to other brokers and retail customers of a block of 150,000 shares of unregistered common stock of Grandma Lee's Inc. (GLI). Kane had been selected by Becker to handle the firm's acquisition of that block. However, he failed to fulfill his duty to make a thorough investigation to determine whether the shares were freely tradeable. In fact, Kane was aware that an officer of GLI was one of the five sellers, and deliberately falsified the new account card relating to the sale to conceal the fact that it was being orchestrated by an officer of the issuer.

In imposing a six-month suspension, the Commission stressed the facts that Kane had abdicated his responsibility to make a searching inquiry, and that it appeared that he had deliberately violated the law. (Rel. 34-23827)

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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### SALOMON BROTHERS MORTGAGE SECURITIES III, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 17 to request a hearing on an application filed by Salomon Brothers Mortgage Securities III, Inc., subsidiary of Salomon Inc., requesting an order exempting it and certain trusts to be created by it from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with the issuance of certain mortgage-backed securities. ### THE ADVANTAGE GOVERNMENT SECURITIES FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 15 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Advantage Government Securities Fund, The Advantage Income Fund, The Advantage Growth Fund, and The Advantage Special Fund, for an order amending a prior order exempting them from the provisions of Section 22(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 22d-1 to permit them to implement a redemption/deposit privilege. ## FORUM GROUP, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 12 to request a hearing on an application filed by Forum Group, Inc., an Indiana corporation, for an order declaring it to be primarily engaged in a business other than that of investing, reinvesting, owning, holding or trading in securities. A temporary order has been issued exempting Forum from all provisions of the Investment Company Act from April 1, 1986 until the Commission shall make a final determination upon the application. 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## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### JERSEY CENTRAL POWER & LIGHT COMPANY; OHIO POWER COMPANY; INDIANA & MICHIGAN ELECTRIC COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until December 15 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24243, dated November 20: Jersey Central Power & Light Company (JCP&L) - subsidiary of General Public Utilities Corporation, to license a series of computer programs relating to "theft of service" designed and created by JCP&L employees; Ohio Power Company - subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, Inc., and by its subsidiaries, Southern Ohio Coal Company (SOCCo) and Windsor Power House Coal Company. SOCCo and Windsor propose to issue, respectively, up to \$135 million and up to \$8 million principal amount of unsecured, fixed-rate notes guaranteed by Ohio Power. SOCCo and Windsor also seek authorization to issue, respectively, from \$25 million to \$50 million and from \$2 million to \$4 million of new notes payable to Ohio Power. The aggregate amount of the notes will not exceed \$160 million for SOCCo and \$10 million for Windsor; and Indiana & Michigan Electric Company - subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, to issue and sell through December 31, 1987 up to \$300 million aggregate principal amount of first mortgage bonds by competitive bidding, and/or unsecured notes under a proposed fixed-rate, term loan agreement.
