# ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

# NASD ACTION AGAINST RICHARD ROUSE MODIFIED

The Commission has modified NASD disciplinary action against Richard J. Rouse of Littleton, Colorado. Rouse was formerly compliance director for Blinder, Robinson & Co. Inc. (Blinder Robinson), a former NASD member firm. The Commission affirmed the NASD's censure of Rouse, but set aside a \$1500 fine and the NASD's requirement that Rouse requalify as a general securities principal.

The Commission found that Rouse was responsible for Blinder Robinson's failure to respond in a timely manner to six NASD requests for information, sent in April-May 1989, in connection with NASD investigations. Although the submissions when finally received were complete, Rouse provided the requested information to the three initial requests and three follow-up letters from 27 to 84 days after the deadline appearing in the initial requests for information. Although it noted that Rouse had not intended to deliberately withhold information from the NASD, the Commission stated

that Rouse's late responses constituted a "refusal" to respond. Rouse also made no attempt to contact the NASD to explain why the deadlines could not be met. The Commission found that Rouse, as the firm's compliance director and addressee on the letters, could be held responsible for the firm's late responses.

Despite its findings of violation, the Commission found the NASD's sanctions excessive. The Commission set aside the fine and requalification requirement, acknowledging the extraordinary demands placed on Rouse at the time of the violations because of the numerous federal and state investigations against Blinder Robinson. It also noted that Rouse had improved Blinder Robinson's compliance procedures and had maintained good relations with regulators. It stated, however, that its decision to set aside certain sanctions "should in no way be read to diminish the importance of timely compliance with the NASD's requests for information." ### COLLEGE RETIREMENT EQUITIES FUND, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 17, 1993 to request a hearing on an application filed by College Retirement Equities Fund (CREF) and TIAA-CREF Individual & Institutional Services, Inc. (together, Applicants) for an order pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act. The order would exempt the arrangement for financing the distribution of CREF's variable annuity certificates from the provisions of Sections 12(b), 26(a)(2) and 27(c)(2) of the Act and Rule 12b-1 thereunder and pursuant to Section 17(d) of the Act and Rule 17d-1 thereunder, approve the same distribution financing arrangement. The order would make permanent certain exemptive relief previously granted by the Commission on a temporary basis. If the relief is granted, Applicants will comply with all applicable provisions of Rule 12b-1 except those relating to shareholder approval. (Rel. IC-19591 - July 23)

#### SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

#### PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>Pacific Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-PSE-93-08) to amend its Rule 5.35(b) governing functions and responsibilities of competing specialists. Publication of the proposal was expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of July 19. (Rel. 34-32651)

#### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the <u>Midwest Securities Trust Company</u> (SR-MSTC-93-1) to accommodate processing of partial calls of uniquely denominated callable securities. (Rel. 34-32667)

#### ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved, on an accelerated basis, a proposed rule change filed by the Midwest Stock Exchange (SR-MSE-93-11), recently renamed the Chicago Stock Exchange. The MSE proposes to add a policy regarding the availability of SuperMAX executions for certain orders systematically generated by the Odd-Lot Execution Service (OLES), the primary odd-lot dealer registered on the Exchange. The SuperMAX program provides that the guaranteed execution price of small agency market orders received over the Midwest Automated Execution System (MAX) are automatically improved according to certain pre-defined criteria. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 26. (Rel. 34-32668)
