The Food Safety and Inspection Service (FSIS) has received the petition submitted by the National Meat Association dated April 10, 2012, requesting that the Agency revise its policy on the marking of display caddies containing meat or poultry products. Under the existing policy, caddies or display cards used to display fully labeled products may not bear an inspection legend and, therefore, are permitted to be reused. The petition requests that FSIS amend or clarify this policy to allow such caddies to bear the mark of inspection while on display in retail facilities for sale to consumers.

Your request is being considered as a petition for policy change under FSIS's petition regulations (9 CFR part 392). Your petition has been referred to the FSIS Office of Policy and Program Development for review and has been assigned petition number 12-03.
