On October 27, 2010, representatives of Comcast, including Matt Bond, Executive Vice President, Content Acquisition; Alan Dannenbaum, Senior Vice President, Content Acquisition; and Kathryn A. Zachem, Vice President, Regulatory and State Legislative Affairs, as well as Arthur Burke of Davis Polk & Wardwell LLP, and David Murray and the undersigned of Willkie Farr & Gallagher LLP, met with the following Commission personnel regarding the above-captioned proceeding: John Flynn, Jennifer Tatel, Jim Bird, Neil Dellar, Nicole McGinnis, and Michael Steffan.

Comcast discussed the procedures governing program access, program carriage, and the *Adelphia Order* conditions, including arbitration, and analyzed each in the context of the instant transaction. Comcast also discussed ways in which the procedures could be improved. These discussions were consistent with the company's submissions in the above-referenced proceeding and in the Commission's rulemaking proceedings regarding program access (MB Docket Nos. 07-29 and 07-198) and program carriage (MB Docket No. 07-42).
