# **Purpose of Export Certification**

- Assures exported U.S. meat and poultry products have been inspected and passed by FSIS.
- FSIS is the competent authority for meat certificates.
- FSIS must maintain integrity, security, and accuracy in the export certification process.

#### **FSIS Form 9060-6**

- Known as the "Application for Export Certificate."
- Must be signed by a plant official.
- Is reviewed and signed by FSIS inspection program personnel.


# **FSIS Form 9060-6**

- A signed "Application for Export Certificate" means:
  - The product is eligible for export to the country;
  - The plant is eligible to export to the country;
  - The plant's export verification program is listed on AMS' Web site; and
  - The eligible product is segregated from ineligible product.



### **FSIS Form 9060-5**

- Known as the "Meat and Poultry Export Certificate of Wholesomeness"
- Is issued by FSIS inspection personnel when the "Application for Export Certificate" is approved.
- Provides MP serial number for export stamp.

### **FSIS Form 9060-5**


