

What is Go.USA.gov?

Go.USA.gov is a URL shortener that lets anyone with a government e-mail address create short, trustworthy .gov URLs to use on online services with character restrictions. **Go.USA.gov** only shortens government URLs - that is: .mil, .gov, .fed.us, and .si.edu URLs.

You must have a verifiable U.S. federal, state, or local government e-mail address to register for a **Go.USA.gov** account. Visit http://go.usa.gov to sign up now.

- Enter a long URL: <u>http://www.usa.gov/Agencies/Federal/All_Agencies/index.shtml</u>. Go.USA.gov will turn it into a short, trustworthy URL like: <u>http://go.usa.gov/1H2</u>
- > The public can click on **Go.USA.gov** URLs and know they will lead to official government information.
- **Go.USA.gov** also tracks the number of clicks each shortened URL receives, allowing users to measure the impact of their outreach.
