

## National Income and Product Accounts Tables

This set of national income and product accounts (NIPAs) tables presents the most recent estimates of gross domestic product (GDP) and its components released on July 29, 2011. These estimates include the advance estimate for the second quarter of 2011 and preliminary estimates for June 2011 for the monthly series. Tables in this section also incorporate estimates from the 2011 annual revision of the NIPAs.

In addition to the regular revision of estimates for the most recent 3 years and for the first quarter of 2011, this “flexible” annual revision includes revisions to current-dollar GDP and some components back to the first quarter of 2003. When estimates for the reference year (2005) were revised, the result was revisions to the levels of the related index numbers and chained-dollar estimates for the entire historical period; revisions to the percent changes before the first quarter of 2003 were small and

were affected only by rounding and interpolation.

Tables 3.18B and 3.20–3.23 are scheduled for the October 2011 issue, and tables 2.9 and 7.20 will be published in the November 2011 issue. Table 3.19 will be published soon after the release of data by the Census Bureau.
