
In 2005, there were 1,234,680 injuries and illnesses with days away from work, roughly the same as in 2004.

There was a decline of 3.5 percent in cases in goods-producing industries. There was no significant change in the number of cases in service-producing industries.

Injuries and illnesses with days away from work represented about 29 percent of total recordable cases in 2005.
