TOPIC: Extension of Airport Emergency Plan Submission Date to June 30,

2011

## **BACKGROUND**

The first version of the Post 9/11 Airport Emergency Plan (AEP) Advisory Circular (AC) 150/5200-31C included several changes for AEP. The AC also required one year to revise and implement changes to the AEP. Several airports reported difficulty meeting the extension of December 31, 2010.

Therefore, the FAA has extended the deadline for <u>submission</u> of the AEP to June 30, 2011. The FAA does not plan to extend the submission date beyond June 30, 2011. If an airport operator holding an FAA Airport Operating Certificate fails to submit the revised AEP by June 30, 2011, the airport operator may not be compliant with Title14, Code of Federal Regulation (CFR) § 139.325.
