Federal Career Service Length of Service Emblem

The Federal Career Service Emblem Pin, along with the DLA Form 35, Certificate of Service is used to recognize long and faithful service and to stimulate employee's pride and interest in their organization and the Federal career service.

The emblem may be awarded in recognition of the completion of 10 years of Federal service and thereafter for each 5-year period. (i.e. 10, 15, 20, 25, 30, 35, 40, 45, etc).

For the purpose of this award, "Federal Service" includes civilian service in departments or Agencies of the Federal Government, service in the municipal government of the District of Columbia and any creditable military service in accordance with the Office of Personnel Management (OPM) regulations, "Creditable Service for Leave Accrual."
