

Automated Export System (AES) Compliance Seminar Virginia Beach, VA - REMINDER



The U.S. Census Bureau experts will cover the filing requirements of the Foreign Trade Regulations (FTR), how to classify your commodities by providing an understanding of the Schedule B classification requirements, and provide a thorough overview of the AES.

The second day will offer an AES *PcLink* Workshop (morning or afternoon session) in which participants can enjoy the benefits of FREE electronic filing of their export information via the Windows-based desktop PC Component AESPcLink. Come learn how to successfully file your export information in this hands-on PC training workshop.
