Background

This report, covering exports during 2000 and 2001, is the sixth in a continuing series of reports profiling U.S. exporters. The first report, *A Profile of United States Exporters: Initial Findings from the Exporter Data Base*, was released by the International Trade Administration in September 1993. That report was based on Census Bureau data compiled both from the 1987 Economic Census and from documents filed for export clearances during 1987 and used a different methodology than the succeeding reports. Reports covering 1992 through 2001 are based on economic census and survey data on file at the Census Bureau, administrative records from other government agencies, and documents filed for export clearances.

These exporter profiles are compiled by the Foreign Trade Division of the U. S. Census Bureau. The International Trade Administration (ITA) is a partial sponsor of the work, providing both financial assistance and advice on data user needs. The ITA also sponsors more detailed tables, which will be available on their Web site later this year. Users will be notified on the ITA Web site (www.ita.doc.gov) when this information is available.

Effective with the 1997/1998 report, companies are classified according to the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS), instead of the Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) system. There are significant differences in the ways NAICS and SIC classify certain types of companies. For example, manufacturers of prepackaged software and books are classified as manufacturers under SIC and as "Other" types of companies under NAICS. Users are advised to consider these differences when making year-over-year comparisons of exporters and exporter characteristics before and after 1997.

The exporter profiles are developed to provide both government and private sector users with information about the exporting community including employment size, type of company, and major foreign markets. In this report these data are presented in Tables 1 through 6, where the export data are designated as part a for 2001, part b for 2000, and part c for the difference between the data for these two years.

The tables in this report include detailed breakdowns based upon the number of employees of the identified exporting companies. In presenting these results, companies are sometimes classified as small (less than 100 employees), medium (100 to 499 employees), and large (500 or more employees). Table 3 also provides information on exports to related parties, such as parent or subsidiary firms. Two parties are considered related if either party owns, directly or indirectly, 10 percent or more of the other party.

All percentages stated in this report, unless otherwise specified, were calculated based solely upon the 2000 and 2001 export values that could be linked to specific exporters--the "known value." For explanations of the methods used in tabulating the information as well as nonsampling errors and other limitations of the export data in this report, see the *Technical Documentation* section that follows Table 6b. Users are advised to consider these limitations when analyzing this information as they may affect the results. Users should cite the Census Bureau, U.S. Department of Commerce as the source of the information in this report but not as the source of their analyses.

Overview

The overall findings for 2000 and 2001 are shown in Exhibits 1 and 2 on the next page. Exhibit 1 shows the proportion of exports matched to specific companies. Exhibit 2 shows exports of these identified exporters by company sizes and types in the two years.

The identified exporting community, consisting of 246,452 companies that exported \$668 billion in merchandise in 2000 and 238,284 companies that exported \$623 billion in merchandise in 2001, represented 85.5 percent of the total export value in both years. Roughly 98 percent of the identified export value was accounted for by the 154,845 companies that exported in both years. The remaining value consisted of low-value estimates of transactions less than \$2,501, shipments by U.S. and foreign governments, and revisions that cannot be attributed to individual companies as well as shipments by unidentified exporters. The distribution of known exports by company size and type are similar in 2000 and 2001. Large exporters (more than 500 employees) continued to account for 71 percent of the known export value with large manufacturers accounting for just over 60 percent of the known export value.

Who Exports?

During 2001, only 13 percent (30,782) of all identified exporters were multiple location companies, but these companies accounted for 79 percent of the known export value (Table 1a). In contrast, 207,502 single location companies, making up 87 percent of the exporting companies, contributed 21 percent of the known export value. Trade with related parties accounted for 38 percent of the known export value by multiple location companies compared to 15 percent by single location companies (Table 3a).

Table 1a also shows that manufacturers represented the largest portion of the 2001 known value at over 71 percent. "Other companies" and wholesalers accounted for 12 percent and 15 percent respectively, and unclassified exporters for the remaining 1 percent. The "other companies" category included manufacturing companies of prepacked software and books; freight forwarders and other transportation and warehousing firms, which often act as agents for the true exporter; business services, engineering and management services; oil and gas extraction companies; coal mining companies; communication services; and others. The distribution mix of exporting companies by type was about the same in 2000 (Table 1b).

Large Exporting Firms

Large exporting companies (those employing 500 or more workers) were responsible for 71 percent of the known export value although they represented less than 4 percent of all identified exporters (Table 1a). Large companies dominate manufacturers' exports, with 5 percent of manufacturing exporters accounting for 85 percent of manufacturing export value. On the other hand, large wholesalers accounted for just 1 percent of the wholesalers who export, and 34 percent of the value of exports by wholesalers. Large exporters in the "other" category represented 4 percent of the companies and 38 percent of the value in the "other" category. Roughly 41 percent of the value of large manufacturers' exports was to related parties (Table 3a).

Among the company types, over 44 percent of the known export value of the manufacturing sector was accounted for by the top 50 manufacturers. For "other companies" and wholesalers, the top 50 firms accounted for about 32 percent of each of their respective sectors' known export value (Table 2a).

Small and Medium-Sized Exporters

Although exports were dominated by a few large companies, most exporting companies were small or medium-sized exporters (those employing fewer than 500 workers). The following findings were extracted from Table 1a:

• Almost 97 percent or 230,736 exporters were small or medium-sized companies; they accounted for about 29 percent of the known export value.

- Over 95 percent of manufacturing exporters were small or medium-sized companies; they contributed 15 percent of the sector's \$444 billion in exports.
- 99 percent of wholesalers were small or medium-sized companies; they attained almost 66 percent of the sector's \$93 billion in exports.
- 96 percent of "other companies" were small or medium-sized companies; they represented nearly 62 percent of the sector's \$77 billion in exports.

Export Markets

Most exporting companies (62 percent) traded with only one foreign country. A small percentage of companies, less than 0.5 percent, shipped to 50 or more countries; these companies accounted for almost half of the known export value (Table 4a).

Over 88 percent of all companies exported to at least one of the top 25 U.S. trading partners in 2001 (Table 5a). The greatest number of companies (100,515) shipped to Canada, followed by Mexico (45,565), the United Kingdom (39,107), Japan (29,166), and Germany (26,228).

Exports by State

The Census Bureau releases data on exports by state based on the origin of movement (OM). The OM series is based on where the goods began their movement to the port of exit as reported on the export document. Table 6 shows the number of companies exporting from each state during 2000 and 2001 based upon the OM definition. Please note that the same company can be shown as exporting from multiple states.

- The top five states based on the number of exporters (California, Florida, New York, Texas, and Illinois) represented 42 percent of the total known export value in 2001.
- North Dakota (9 percent), Montana (5 percent), and Texas (3 percent) showed slight increases in identified exporters in 2001.

Comparison of 2000 and 2001 Results

The relative proportions of exports accounted for by manufacturers, wholesalers, and "other companies" based upon both number of exporters and value of exports remained consistent from 2000 to 2001. Below are a number of noteworthy year-to-year changes (Tables 1c and 5c):

• Overall, the number of exporting companies decreased by 8,168 or 3 percent, where single location companies accounted for 71 percent of the decline from 2000 to 2001.

- The number of small and medium-sized companies decreased over 3 percent from 238,529 in 2000 to 230,736 in 2001, while the number of large companies decreased by almost 5 percent from 7,923 to 7,548.
- The number of "other companies" decreased by 5 percent from 90,331 in 2000 to 85,866 in 2001.
- Among the top 25 U.S. trading partners, China (8 percent) and Saudi Arabia (4 percent) showed the largest increase in the number of exporting companies. The Philippines and Israel (-6 percent each) showed the largest decline from 2000.

Some portion of these changes may reflect changes in the match rate rather than an actual change in the number of exporters. During the process of identifying individual companies, it was not possible to investigate every unmatched case. Priority was given to identifying unmatched companies having high values of trade. As a result, the information on small exporters is most likely understated. Therefore, users should not assume that the unidentified exporters reflected the same distribution of company types and sizes as the identified (known) exporters. Comparisons between the number of companies exporting in given categories or different years might be somewhat misleading due to differences in the percentage of value we were able to match to specific companies.

Technical Documentation

NOTE TO USERS: This section contains important information on sources and reliability of data, as well as, definitions of terms and methodological procedures that users should consider before attempting to interpret or analyze the statistical data presented in this report. Failure to do so may affect the results.

Sources of Information

The 2000 and 2001 exporter profiles were created from export merchandise trade documentation and company characteristics contained in the Census Bureau's data base of company information, the Business Register. Company characteristics are gathered through economic censuses and surveys and supplemented with employment and payroll information provided by the Internal Revenue Service. The export trade statistics, with the exception of exports to Canada, are compiled from Shipper's Export Declarations, or their electronic equivalent, which were filed by U.S. exporters or their agents for merchandise exiting the United States. The data for exports to Canada are derived from Canada's import data via the U.S./Canada data exchange.

Methodology

This profile was compiled using company identifiers or company names reported on export documentation to electronically link export trade data to company characteristics in the Business Register. Less than 3 percent of the total export value for each year, including low-value estimates, exports by U.S. and foreign governments, timing adjustments, and end-of-year revisions, was excluded from this matching process because the export transactions cannot be attributed to specific exporting companies. Other transactions that could not be matched electronically were investigated and linked manually to specific companies using a combination of criteria, including company name, location, type, and product. A comparison of the overall match rates in 2000 and 2001 based on export value is presented in Exhibit 1 under *Distribution of Exports by Identified and Unidentified Exporters*, at the beginning of this profile report.

It was not possible to investigate every unmatched transaction, so priority was given to those with the highest export values. The percentage of unidentified value tends to decrease each year as more companies are identified and value thresholds triggering investigation are lowered. Therefore, users should make year-to-year comparisons with caution and be aware that the number of small exporting companies and their associated known value are most likely understated. Similarly, the known value may not reflect all shipments by identified companies.

Data Quality

Quality assurance procedures were applied to all phases of collection, processing and tabulation of the information in this report to minimize errors. However, the data are still subject to nonsampling errors in data reporting (of the basic export trade statistics and the administrative record source data), coding, keying, and in coverage (due to failure to identify all exporting companies). For an explanation of nonsampling errors affecting the trade statistics, see the **Information on Goods and Services** section of the December 2001 *U.S. International Trade in Goods and Services* (FT-900), page 26 or call (301) 763-2227 to request a copy of the release.

The characteristics of exporting companies in this report only reflect companies that could be matched to the Business Register. When analyzing these data, users should consider the possible impact of unmatched transactions and unidentified exporters on their results. Unidentified exporters may not reflect the same distribution of company types and sizes as identified exporting companies. Similarly, comparisons between the number of companies exporting in given categories may be misleading due to differences in the percentage of value matched to companies of various types and sizes.

Year-over-year comparisons should also be made with caution. Changes in the number of exporters and the value of their export transactions, the known value, may be due to differences in match rates, as well as, to exporters entering or dropping out of the export market. Exhibit 1, under *Distribution of Exports by Identified and Unidentified Exporters*, at the beginning of this report shows a comparison of the match rates, based on export value, for 2000 and 2001 as well as the value attributable to exporters that exported in both years.

Data by State

The Census Bureau released two state export series from 1993 through 2002, the Exporter Location (EL) and the Origin of Movement (OM). Neither of these series reflected production origin. The EL state was derived from the ZIP code in the reported address of the USPPI (U.S. Principal Party in Interest). The EL series was designed to indicate the location of the exporter or the division of multiple location companies responsible for the export. However, in the case of multiple location companies, it could represent the corporate headquarters or the billing address. Similarly, the OM series does not always accurately represent the state where the merchandise started it's export journey, particularly in the case of agricultural or other bulk shipments that may reflect a consolidation point or where agricultural grains are stored prior to exportation from the United States.

Effective with January 2003 statistics the EL series is being discontinued. Due to new methods of reporting exporter addresses, the EL state totals showed significant shifts in 2000 and 2001 that were inconsistent with exporter location criteria. The OM series should not be affected by these changes in reporting. Definitions of Terms

Business Register. Data base of companies included in economic census and surveys conducted by the Census Bureau.

Company. A company is a business consisting of one domestic location (single location company) or more than one domestic location (multiple location company) under its ownership or control.

<u>Identified Companies</u>: Identified companies are those companies to which one or more export transactions were matched. The export value associated with these companies is termed "known value."

<u>Unclassified Companies</u>: These are identified companies for which no NAICS classification (manufacturers, wholesalers or other companies) could be assigned.

Company Size. Company sizes are based on employment: small (less than 100 employees), medium (100 - 499 employees), and large (500 or more employees).

Company Type. Company types are based on the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) and are broken out into manufactures, wholesalers, and all other companies. Those companies for which a valid NAICS code is not available are placed in the *unclassified* grouping.

Employment. Employment includes all employees, full-time or part-time, reported on a firm's payroll during specific payroll periods in 2000 and 2001.

Low-value Estimates. Export transactions valued under \$2,501 are not required to be reported. Instead, the Census Bureau estimates the value of such shipments to each country using factors based on the ratios of low-valued shipments to individual country totals for past periods.

Related Party. A related party transaction is one between a U.S. exporter and a foreign consignee, where either party owns (directly or indirectly) 10 percent or more of the other party.

State of the Origin of Movement (OM). The OM series data provides export statistics based on the state from which the merchandise starts its journey to the port of export; i.e., the transportation origin. This information is reported by the exporter. See the *Data Quality* section above for limitations of this data series.

Value. The values in this report are f.a.s. ("free alongside ship") and include both domestic exports and re-exports of foreign merchandise. Several different values are given:

<u>Total export value</u>: The total value includes all transactions whether or not linked to specific companies.

<u>Known value</u>: The value of transactions linked to specific companies. All percentages given for company size and types are based on known value.

<u>Unidentified Value</u>: The valued transactions that were not linked to a specific company. Note that these

shipments might have been exported either by identified companies or by other companies not identified in the linking process.
