Description of Sample

20 whole cantaloupes were collected as part of an investigation for ongoing listeria outbreak at a melon producer (10 are 702(b) portion by request of owner).

Method of Collection

20 whole cantaloupes (subs 1-10) were collected asseptically using sterile gloves by CSO Dion, assisted by Clark Wilson, Environmental Protection Specialist of the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment during EI of the grower/dealer. 2 randomly selected melons were collected from each of 2 randomly selected cases on each of 2 pallets in the walk-in cooler for a total of 8 melons. Another 2 melons were collected from each of 3 randomly selected cases on each of 2 pallets in the walk in cooler for a total of 12 melons. The 2 melons from each case were placed together in one sterile whirpack bag for a total of 10 whirlpacks (20 melons). The lot consisted of 4 pallets in total that were packed on Thursday 9/8/11 and were awaiting shipment along with pallets packed on Saturday 9/10/11.

How Prepared

Two cantaloupes were placed into sterile whirlpack bags and whirled closed. Each bag was identified in black pen with a sub number (subs 1-10). Subs 1-5 were placed in a black plastic bag, rolled closed, taped closed, offical FDA sealed and FDA 525 attached and placed in cooler for transport to lab. Subs 6-10 were placed in a second black plastic bag (see remarks).

Remarks

Send 704(d) sample results to Ryan D. Jensen, Owner at 31 N. Cline St. Granada, CO 81041. A control of the whirlpack bags could not be submitted due to lack of whirlpacks in same size. Samples were returned to sample prep room and kept under seal in locked room refrigerator overnight. Hand delivered to lab staff on 9/11/11 by DIB Paul Teitell. Original FDA 463a attached to EIR. Continued from How Prepared: goosenecked, taped closed, official FDA sealed and FDA 525 attached. Placed in a cooler with ice for transport to DEN-LAB.
