Practice using resources designed to streamline the search process. Develop search strategies that can be adapted, modified, and translated into classroom success.

Objectives:

Participants will be able to:

- Use different Library of Congress Web site search tools;
- Search and browse American Memory in a variety of ways;
- Select appropriate search strategies to conduct a search;
- Use resources on the Learning Page to shortcut the search process.

Tasks in brief:

- Practice sample searches using the search tools on the Library of Congress Home Page, Prints & Photographs Online Catalog, Today in History, THOMAS, and American Memory.
- Use the indexes and other linked search terms within the American Memory collections.
- Use Learning Page resources in Features & Activities, Community Center, and Collection Connections to search for relevant items on the Library's Web site.
