Entry Update: ACE/ACS Interface

- February Drops
 - Number of transactions were reduced for release messaging between ACE and ACS
 - Port Code Mismatch Issue resolved
 - Should see across the board improvement




Entry Update: B35 Report

- From a high of 35,008 to a low of 14,000.
 - Ports from around the country are seeing the benefit to catching up on the B35
 - Looking to do another clean up this year of the 2006-2008 entries
 - Focus on land border
 - Goal is to get to 10,000 by end of year
 - Furthers the notion that our teams have straightened out a lot of the interface issues between ACE and ACS

Entry Update: New Edits for Cargo Release

- Manufacturer ID
 - Validation will reject an entry if MID is not on file
 - Benefits
 - Will help reduce the B35 report
 - Will reduce operational strain at the port level for both CBP and the private sector

- Foreign Trade Zone (FTZ)
 - Zone estimate will now have opportunity to go paperless
 - Benefit
 - Documentation will no longer need to be presented unless requested
 - Smooth out zone processes



Participating Government Agency (PGA) Set

- Participating Government Agencies Transaction Set
 - 40+ Agencies will be covered
 - Years of effort by the ITDS Department to consolidate all the data requirements of the Participating Government Agencies into a universal data set
 - This is a proactive move by the government that will create a tremendous number of efficiencies for both the trade software community and CBP



Participating Government Agency (PGA) Set

- CATAIR Participating Government Agencies
 - Has its own chapter
 - Will eventually replace the OGA record sets
 - Built with an eye to the future
 - Programming will not be thrown away
 - Captured on 30 Records
 - 20 Records Unique
 - 10 Records Repeatable
 - Listed in Section 2 in draft records
 - Records are in 80 byte formats
 - DO NOT PROGRAM NOW!
 - PG set is in a state of flux, since the data is still being vetted.
 - Records are listed as "DRAFT"



Unrestricted

- Subset of the PGA Data Set
 - Design
 - 8 Unique Records
 - 2 Repeating
 - Covers about 19 data elements
 - Programmed from the requirements laid out on the PPQ505 form.
 - Note: Trade does not have to program for everything listed, but does have to program for Lacey Act data.



PPQ 505

- Data Elements
 - Many of the data elements that relate to the APHIS form PPQ
 505 are already captured by current transactions
 - Captured Data Elements at the Entry Level
 - Estimated Date of Arrival
 - Entry Number
 - Bill of Lading
 - Importer Name/Address
 - Consignee Name/Address
 - MID
 - Tariff Level Description (OI Record)
 - HTS Number



PPQ 505 (cont)

- New Elements Collected
 - Container Number
 - If no container number, leave blank
 - Intended Use
 - This is required on the PPQ form and can be found under instruction #10
 - "Enter the name of the plant or plant product and its use"
 - Entered Value
 - Article or Component of Article
 - Plant Scientific Name
 - Country of Harvest
 - Quantity of Plant Material/Unit of Measure
 - % Recycled Material



Unrestricted

Data Records

- PG01 follows the OI record
 - PGA Line Number
 - A sequenced number that follows the description of the cargo at the line level
 - Agency Qualifier
 - For Now will only be "AP"
 - Intended Use Code
 - Appendix Q
 - Intended Use Description
 - If "other," this is required and is free hand text



Data Records (cont)

- PG04
 - Name of the Constituent Element
 - Element of wood product
 - Quantity of Constituent Element
 - Unit of Measure
 - Percent of Constituent Element
 - Used in circumstances where paper or particle board is recycled
 - If this information is supplied, the records PG05/PG06 or PG15/PG16 are not necessary



Data Records (cont)

- PG05/PG06
 - These two record sets must be married together
- PG05
 - Scientific Genus Name/Species
 - Instruction 14 of the PPQ 505 form states that there can be multiples of the Genus name especially if there is uncertainty as to the Genus Name
- PG06
 - Source Type/Code
 - This will indicate the product origin
 - Country Code
 - Where the processing, harvesting etc..., took place

Data Records (cont)

- PG15/16 are duplicates of the PG05/PG06 records above
 - PG 15/16 are used in cases where there are multiples of the Genus Name and Species and the Country of Origin
- PG 25
 - PGA Value
 - At the line level
 - Outside of the component material
- PG 27
 - Container Number
 - If there is no container number, then leave blank

Commodity: Wooden tables made of Oak

OI Wooden Desk – Oak

PG01 001 AP Home Use

PG04 OAK 100 ft

PG05 OAKUS BIGGUS

PG06 HRV Canada

PG25 10000

PG27 MAEUXXXX



Implementation

- Implementation 1 of the Lacey Act is due April 2009
 - AE is scheduled to come on line in June 2009.
- Implementation Phases
 - Phase 1 (Present March 31, 2009): Voluntary Compliance
 - Phase 2* (April 1 September 30, 2009): HTS Ch. 44 (portions)
 - Phase 3* (October 1, 2009 March 31, 2010): HTS Ch. 44 & 47 (portions)
 - Phase 4* (April 1 September 30, 2010): HTS Ch. 44, 48, & 94 (portions)
 - * Each phase includes the HTS Chapters from all previous phases



- Implementation 1 (OIT):
 - No correction capability once through selectivity
 - Data to be turned in with formal entries
 - If forgotten or correction needed SSAD and resubmit or turn in paper
 - HN/HI/EI
 - Sequence must be accurate
 - ACE AE will pass data to ACS
- Implementation 2:
 - Date TBD
 - Will match data to HTSUSA
 - Hard edits, outbound messaging and corrections
