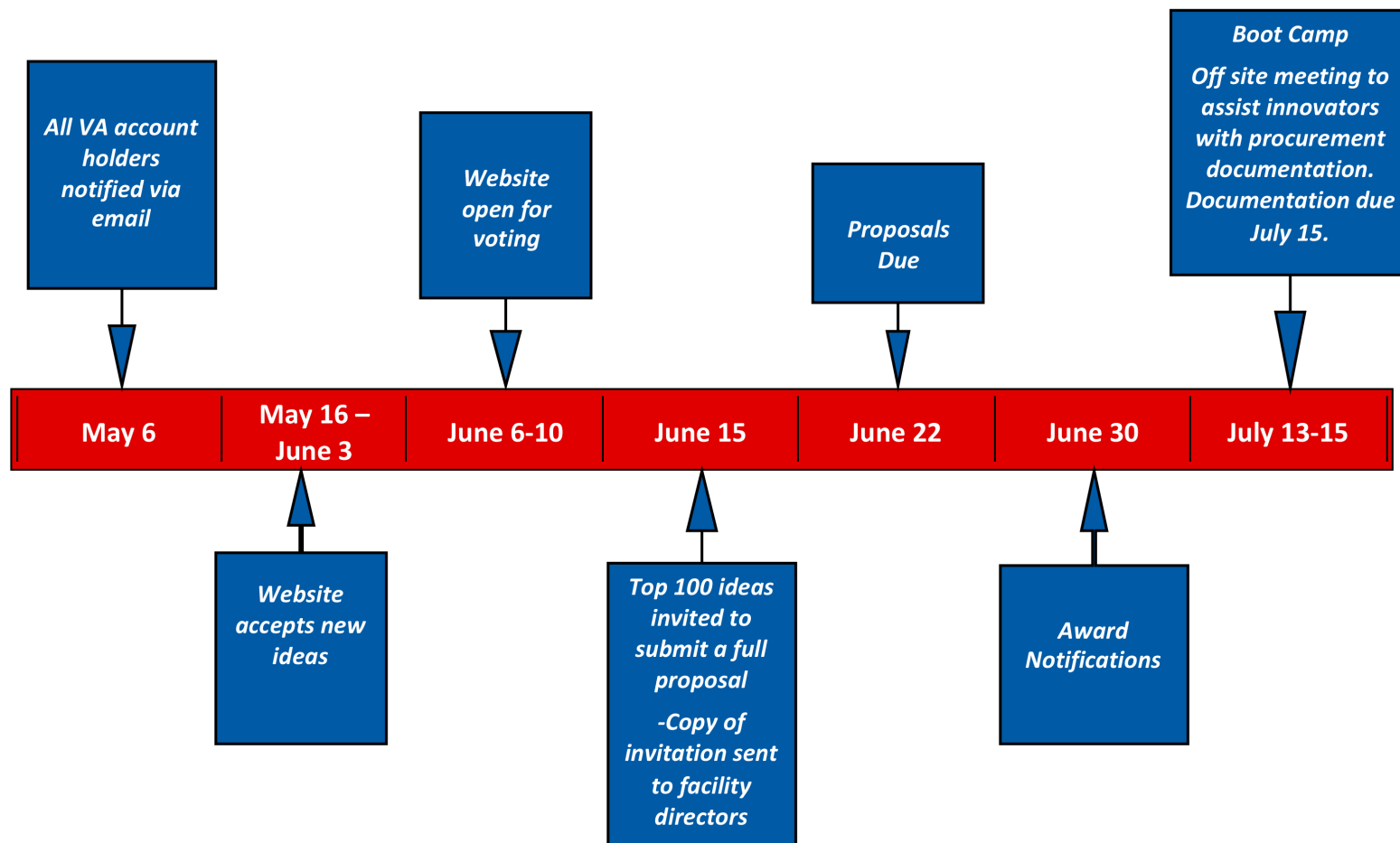
Judging Criteria Favor Bold Ideas That Enable Your Work

- Improve patient care
 - Safety, quality, access
- Improve efficiency
 - Clinical workflow, cost/benefit, cost avoidance
- Affect numerous Veterans, staff, or other stakeholders
- Address an unmet need rather than incrementally improve existing methods
- Help meet an organizational requirement
 - The Joint Commission or Congressional mandate
