Abstract: Clergyman and founder of the Free Methodist Church of North America. Family and general correspondence, diaries, notebooks, speeches and writings, and other papers of Benjamin Titus Roberts and members of his family concerning family and domestic matters; the Free Methodist Church; the Chili Seminary, later A. M. Chesbrough Seminary, in North Chili, New York; South America; and matters relating to the allied Rice, Sellew, and Stowe families.

## Scope and Content Note

The Benjamin Titus Roberts Family Papers cover the years 1832-1954, with the bulk of the collection dating from 1870 to 1900. Roberts was the founder of the Free Methodist Church of North America and also of the Chili Seminary of North Chili, New York, renamed the A. M. Chesbrough Seminary in 1885 and Roberts Wesleyan College in 1949. Although the collection contains the papers of many family members, the largest sections consist of the papers of Roberts's wife, Ellen Lois Stowe Roberts, and their son, Benson Howard Roberts. Their papers document the development of the Free Methodist Church and of the seminary at North Chili. The papers are organized into the following series: [Anna A. Rice Roberts Papers](#), [Benjamin Titus Roberts Papers](#), [Benson Howard Roberts Papers](#), [Ellen Lois Stowe Roberts Papers](#), [Emma J. Sellew Roberts Papers](#), [George Lane Roberts Papers](#), [Other Family Members](#), and [Addition](#).

The papers of [Benjamin Titus Roberts](#) consist chiefly of diaries, notebooks, and family and general correspondence. There are few items documenting his religious activities. Among the more informative manuscripts are letters to his wife Ellen in the family correspondence series of her papers. More correspondence of Benjamin Titus Roberts can be found in the family and general correspondence and the correspondence with overseas missionaries in the [Addition](#) series. A correspondence file in the papers of [Ellen Lois Stowe Roberts](#) relates the activities of her husband, four of their sons and their wives, and various personalities associated with the Free Methodist Church.

The papers of [Benson Howard Roberts](#), clergyman and principal of the A. M. Chesbrough Seminary, and his wife [Emma J. Sellew Roberts](#), consist chiefly of general correspondence, circa 1870-1904, relating to the operation of the school. There are also research notes for Benson's biography of his father, Benjamin Titus Roberts (1900).

The papers of [George Lane Roberts](#) concern his law practice and real estate ventures and his brief residence in South America. The papers of his first wife, [Anna A. Rice Roberts](#), consist chiefly of correspondence with the Rice and Roberts family members and with her friends.

An [Addition](#) to the collection includes correspondence of various family members, booklets documenting the dissension and division within the Genesee Conference of the Methodist Church in the 1850s, and correspondence and documents concerning the overseas missionary work of the Free Methodist Church during the 1880s and 1890s. There are lengthy letters to Ellen Lois Stowe Roberts and Benjamin Titus Roberts from various missionaries stationed in India and Africa, particularly in South Africa and Liberia.
