Scope and Content Note

The papers of Raymond G. Carroll (1876?-1943) span the years 1905-1944 and consist chiefly of scrapbooks containing clippings of Carroll's articles for newspapers in Illinois, Ohio, and Missouri and for the *Philadelphia Public Ledger*, the *Times* of London, and the *New York Evening Post*. Other items in the collection include correspondence, photographs, drawings, and miscellaneous printed matter.
