Biographical Note

Könstantinos Apostolou Doxiadēs, architect and urban planner, was born in Stenimachos, Greece, on May 14, 1913. He graduated as an architect-engineer from the Technical University of Athens in 1935, and earned his doctorate in engineering in 1936 from the Berlin-Charlottenburg University in Berlin, Germany. In 1940, he married Emma Scheepers.

In 1951, he founded Doxiadis Associates, a private firm of consulting engineers, which grew to have offices around the world. Doxiadēs taught at the Athens Technical Institute as a professor of ekistics from 1958 to 1971. He published *Ekistics: An Introduction to the Science of Human Settlements* in 1968. He died in Greece on June 28, 1975.

Doxiadēs was primarily known as Constantinos Apostolos Doxiadis.

Scope and Content Note

The papers of Könstantinos Apostolou Doxiadēs (1913-1975) span the years 1959-1976, and constitute the remaining personal and professional files kept by Doxiadēs at the Georgetown office of Doxiadis Associates in Washington, D.C. A great bulk of material was discarded by a disposal firm cleaning out the offices in 1977. Doxiadēs was one of the chief persons involved in the Georgetown Waterfront project. After his death, Doxiadis Associates was dissolved in the United States and its activities were taken over by other companies in the network of firms working on the project. The papers consist of correspondence, reports and proposals, photographs, architectural drawings and plans, financial records, printed matter, and miscellaneous material.

Arrangement of the Papers

This collection is organized into correspondence, subject file, miscellany, and oversize groupings and alphabetically therein by topic, organization, name of person, or type of material.
