## **iWATCH WEST POINT**

Welcome to the iWATCH website, where you can report suspicious activities or behaviors that may indicate terrorist or criminal activity.

**iWATCH**, **iREPORT**, I KEEP US SAFE (iWATCH) is a community awareness program created to educate the Army community about behaviors and activities that may have a connection to terrorism and criminal activity. This Department of the Army mandated program will be the way ahead as the "Army's 21<sup>st</sup> Century Neighborhood Watch Program." It is designed to be a partnership between our West Point community and the Directorate of Emergency Service. "We can and must work together to report and to prevent terrorist attacks or criminal activity."

## How can I get involved?

The iWATCH program allows community members to report suspicious activities by calling the West Point Military Police Desk at (845) 938-3333 or by filling out a <u>suspicious activity report</u>. This site is not designed to report emergencies. For emergencies dial 911.

## What should I report?

Significant information often develops from a series of apparently unconnected unusual incidents. One observation may be the missing piece of the puzzle. Particular behaviors and activities to report are:

- \* People drawing or measuring important buildings
- \* People asking questions about cadet or Soldier movements
- \* Vehicles left in no parking zones/vehicles without registration or license plates
- \* Suspicious packages left unattended or out of place
- \* People asking questions about security forces, security measures, or sensitive information
- \* People in restricted areas where they are not supposed to be

The effectiveness of our Force Protection Program depends in large part on the personal involvement of all community members. Vigilance and awareness are our watchwords. Early recognition and reporting of potential terrorist and criminal activity is the first line of defense against those whom intend to harm members of our community and its assets. Stay alert as you go about your daily business and become familiar with the normal routines of your neighborhood, community and workplace. Understanding these routines will help you spot anything out of place. And as always...
