Currently MP Branch at HRC is looking for motivated Soldiers for an exciting career opportunity.

Who? Military Police Soldiers (31B) Specialist through Sergeants (E4/E5)

What? Assignment Instructions to Korea with Military Police Investigator (MPI) Course in route.

When? This is an ongoing requirement that is always in need of serious inquiries.

Why? Currently Military Police Investigators are needed to fill requirements in Korea. Soldiers are needed to go to training before they report to Korea in order to maximize time on station and benefit of training.

How? Contact MP Branch at HRC or MP Proponent Office at USAMPS for detailed instructions as well as records screening. After a conversation is started with MP Branch you will need to submit a Criminal Records Check (CRC) through your local MPI office before HRC can place you on Assignment Instructions with MPI Course date in route. Some Soldiers get discouraged while the CRC is going on and decide to work another assignment or pursue another option. The CRC can take several weeks to complete in some cases and is required before you can be placed in school. During this process please get your Chain Of Command involved for guidance. This mission has top level support all of your Brigade and Battalion Command Sergeants Majors have been briefed and have been encouraged to assist Soldiers who are interested and qualified.
