SUBJ: New Alignment of Contract Legal Counsel Responsibilities

- 1. This Information Letter (IL) provides notice to contracting officers that the Office of General Counsel (OGC) will transfer responsibility for providing legal counsel on certain procurement matters specifically identified below, including legal review responsibilities, to Regional Counsel, effective January 1, 2008. The Regional Counsel (RC) presently responsible for providing legal counsel to management and staff of VA facilities in other areas of law, e.g., personnel and medical malpractice, is the RC that will be responsible for providing procurement counsel on matters set forth below. - 2. The matters being transferred will include those originating at the field level and will encompass legal reviews from the presolicitation stage through contract dispute resolution. The affected actions shall include the following:
 - Minor VHA Facilities Construction (under \$10M)
 - Non-Recurring Maintenance VHA Facilities (no \$ threshold)
 - *VBA minor construction (VBA's construction program is de minimus, the majority of its space is acquired via leasing)
 - Supplies & services (except any supply or service contracts issued by any of the entities named in paragraph 3 as work PSG V is retaining)
 - 38 USC § 8153 Sharing Agreements

- Task orders issued in accordance with the September 2007 National Memorandum of Understanding between Corp of Engineers and VA
- 3. The following matters will remain under the purview of Professional Staff Group V:
 - Major VHA and NCA Construction
 - All NCA Contract Matters
 - Major Leases: Leases over \$600,000 annual rental or more than 10,000 net usable square feet
 - National Acquisition Center
 - Denver Acquisition and Logistics Center
 - Health Administration Center (Denver) Matters
 - Austin Automation Center
 - All IT Buys: Hardware, Software, Licenses, notwithstanding contracting activity
 - Contracts developed and awarded by Central Office's OA&L
 - Economy Act and Other Government Agency Agreements
 - 38 USC §8111 VA DoD Sharing Agreements
 - Tricare Agreements
 - Utility Agreements & Energy Savings Performance Contracts
- 4. All documents requiring legal review and/or concurrence should be forwarded to either the Regional Counsel or to Professional Staff Group V.
