MIP 86-CLNC-140-FAC, WASTE PETROLEUM (FUEL OIL)

The following is a status report on the investigation of waste oil collection sites. The results of the investigation have revealed that there is a significant problem with waste oil disposal, as delineated in the MIP. Of particular note is that waste oil collection sites have been fairly unregulated and unstructured. This is evidenced by the very fact that 5-gallon cans are being collected and that there are multiple tanks, large and small, at a single location. The "bottom line" reveals that a serious study generating a waste oil collection plan needs to be conducted for CLNC on the problem before the MIP can be fully evaluated. However, we obviously believe the problem addressed in the MIP is genuine.

1. Accordingly, it is recommended that NREAD be tasked with conducting or coordinating a study for waste oil collection and that this MIP be held in abeyance until the study is concluded.
