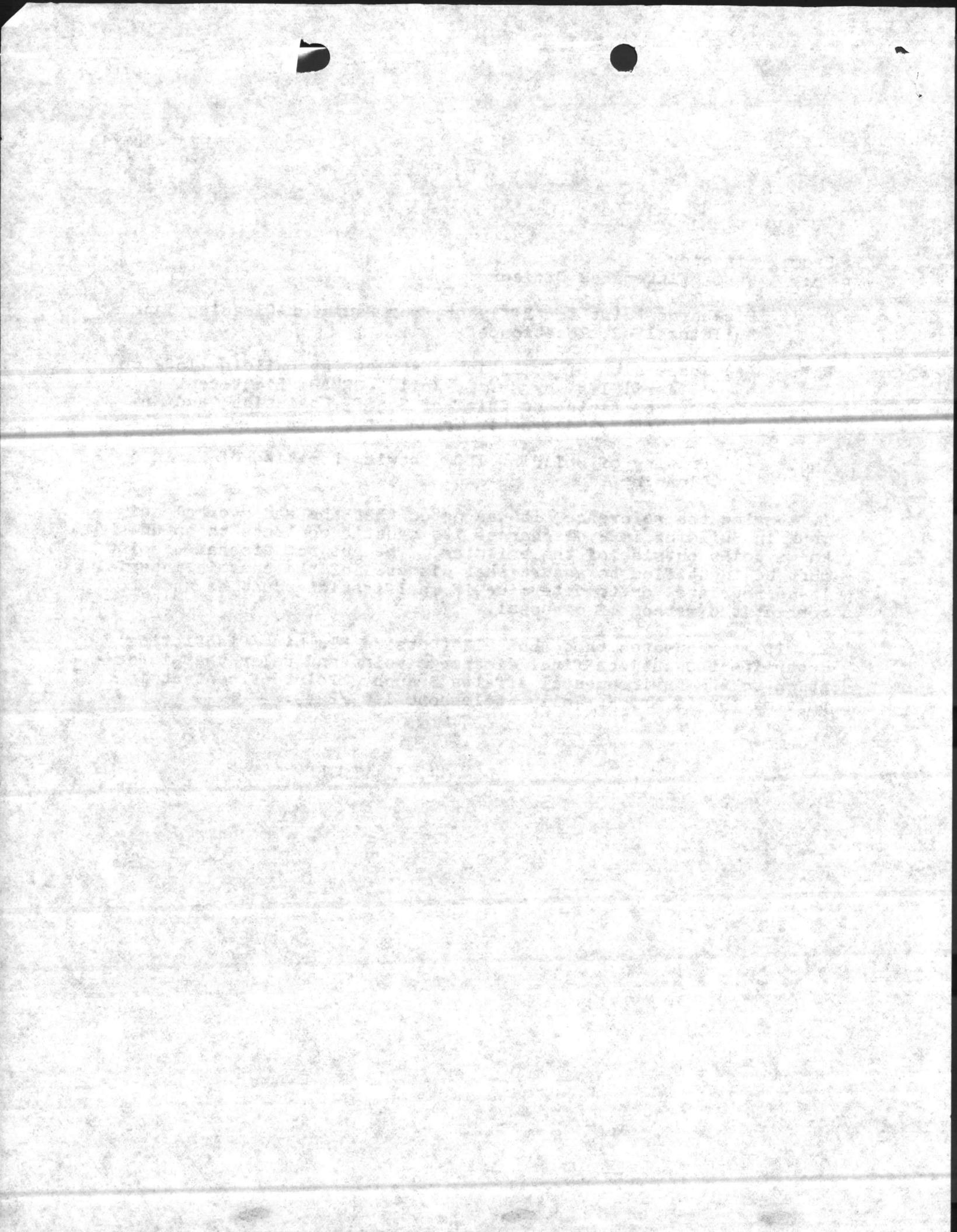

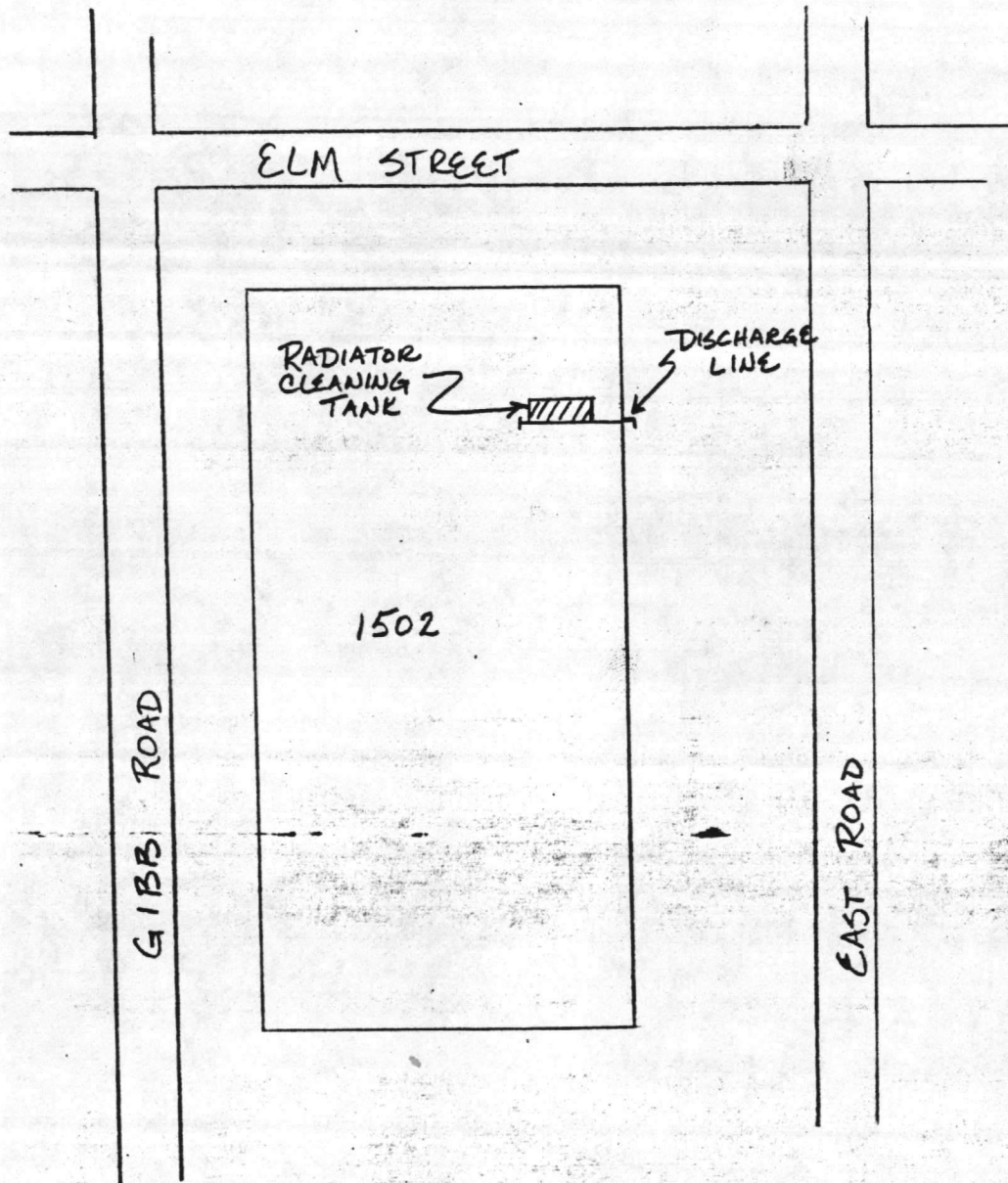
Encl: (1) Drawing of Building 1502 Showing Location of Radiator Cleaning Tank

1. During the reference, it was noted that the radiator cleaning tank in Building 1502 discharges its caustic contents to an unknown point outside of the building. The subject discharge point must be identified to assure that disposal of the caustic material is appropriate, or to determine if modifications must be made to correct the method of disposal.

2. It is requested that Shop 61B (Outside Plumbing/Pipefitting) determine the subject final discharge point and relay that information to the Environmental Affairs Branch. Point of contact in this matter is Mr. K. Jolly, telephone 1690/2083.
