

3. Pertaining to timber removal, it is estimated a minimum of 18 months would be required to remove the timber.

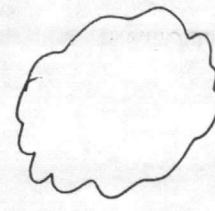
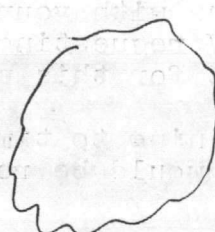
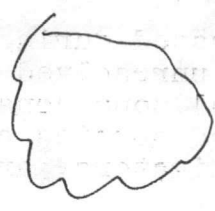
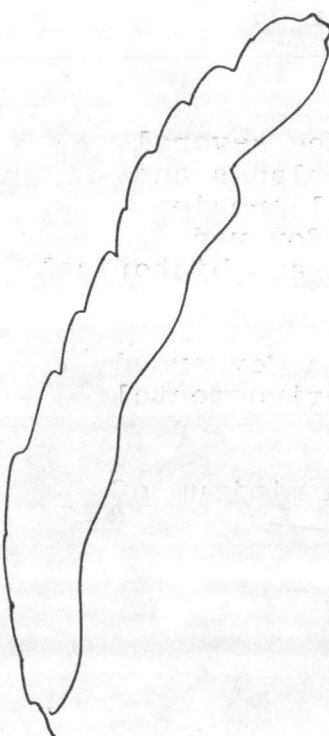
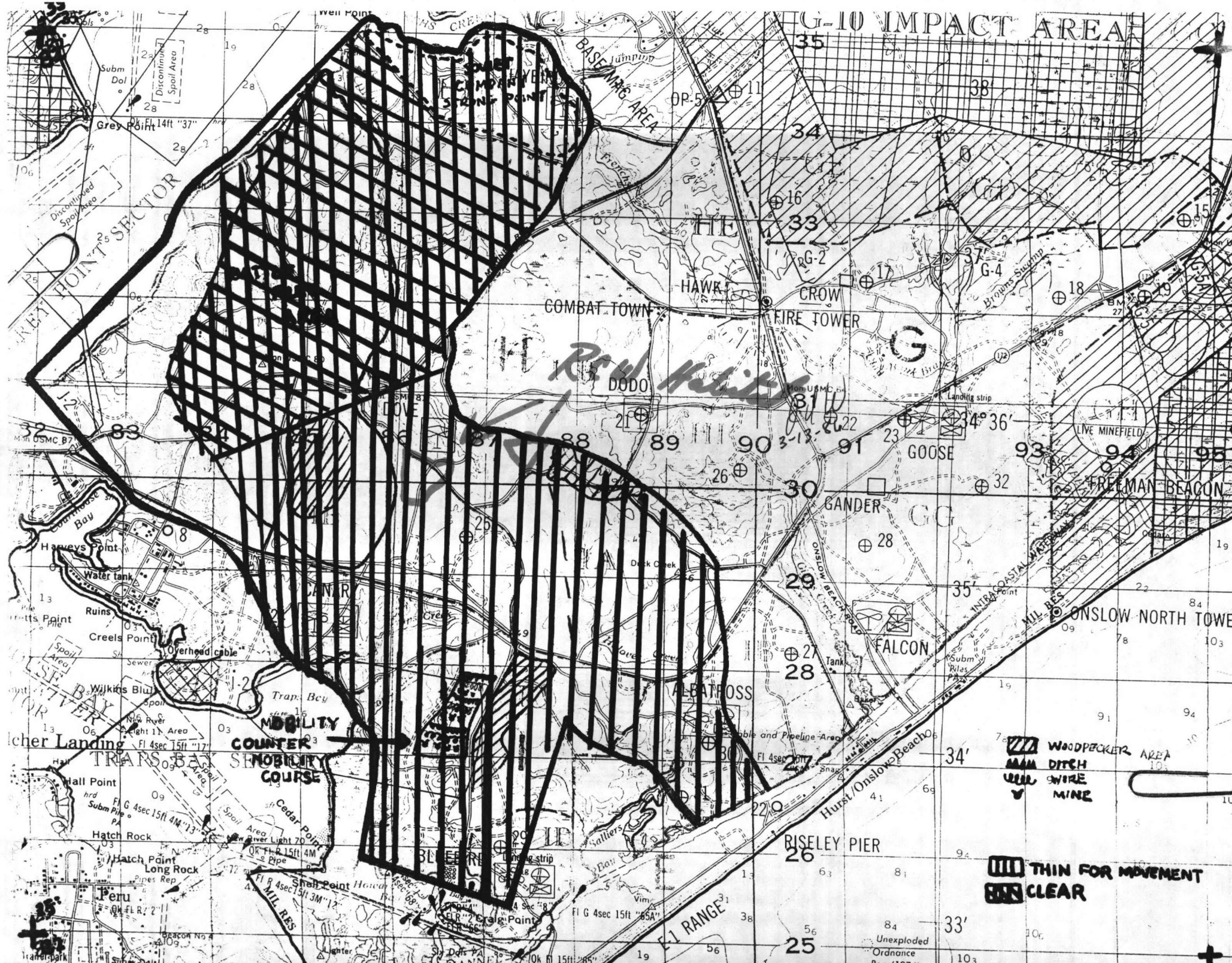








FIG-10 IMPACT AREA
