1. Please follow these instructions for the use of the attached application sheet and other requirements in detail adhering to the scheduled dates noted. All information provided is to be typed or printed legibly. Your application should be submitted to our office as soon as possible. Other requested supporting documents are to be submitted as you complete or receive them. However, all information must be received in our office no later than **November 13, 2012**. **IMPORTANT: Senator Inouye does not have any Naval Academy vacancy for the class entering in July, 2013.**

2. The following supporting documents are required as part of your application for the review process to be considered for Senator Inouye's nominations:

- a. An official transcript of high school grades.
- b. A 200 word essay on why you desire to attend a Service Academy.
- c. Two letters of recommendation. One to be from one of your high school teachers.
- d. Copies of your latest SAT or ACT reports.
- e. A small photograph of yourself. (Passport type photo size is acceptable)

3. **Important actions to support this application:** Interest Cards must be submitted to the appropriate Military Academies as early as possible at the start of your Senior year. Upon your receipt of the Pre-Candidate Questionnaires, you must complete and return all information requested by the Academies to start initial screening by the academic entrance review boards. Starting in October, Senator Inouye receives biweekly reports from the Academies on preliminary ratings for each prospect being processed. It cannot be overstated that it is important that all requirements, documents and/or information requested by the Service Academies, be submitted promptly so this process may provide an accurate profile of each applicant.

4. Senator Inouye's selection process of individuals for his nomination is based on meeting profiles considered necessary to assure appointment and the successful completion of the rigorous leadership, academic, and physical requirements of the Service Academies. The final phase of his selection process is an oral interview. It is imperative that each applicant meet the criteria listed below to be scheduled and proceed to the final or oral interview phase of Senator Inouye's nomination process:

- a. The application and all above specified documents have been submitted by the dates required.
- b. Have SAT scores of 1200 or higher and/or ACT scores of 27 or higher.
- c. Completion of the DODMRB (medical exam) and the CFA (physical strength test).

5. **Application Processing Schedule:**

November 13	Deadline for completed application and supporting documents.
By November 21	Applicants selected for oral interviews will be notified.
Mid-December	Interviews in the Senator's Honolulu Office.
By January 31	Notification to individuals selected for Senator Inouye's nomination.
