3 SECTION 1. CALCULATION OF WITHDRAWALS.

- 4 (a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:
- 5 (1) RETURN FLOW.—
- 6 (A) IN GENERAL.—The term "return flow" 7 means a discharge that flows directly or indi-8 rectly into a reservoir from a wastewater or 9 water supply system in accordance with applica-10 ble Federal law (including regulations).

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(B) EXCLUSION.—The term "return flow"
does not include a discharge of storm water
that would have flowed into a reservoir de scribed in subparagraph (A) in the absence of
a discharge by a non-Federal entity.
(2) SECRETARY.—The term "Secretary" means
the Secretary of the Army, acting through the Chief

9 (b) CALCULATION OF RETURN FLOW.—At the re-10 quest of a State in which a Federal reservoir operated by 11 the Secretary is located, the Secretary shall calculate the 12 aggregate withdrawals of a non-Federal entity by sub-13 tracting any return flow from the aggregate withdrawals 14 of the non-Federal entity.
